#### 1. International Day of Persons with Disabilities: 03 December

- ➢ International Day of Persons with Disabilities is observed annually on 03 December to promote rights and wellbeing of persons with disabilities.
- The theme for International Day of Persons with Disabilities 2021 is "Leadership and participation of persons with disabilities toward an inclusive, accessible and sustainable post-COVID-19 world."
- United Nations General Assembly had proclaimed 03 December as International Day of Persons with Disabilities in 1992.
- Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) was adopted in 2006. It is an international treaty for the protection of rights and dignity of disabled people.

### 2. Government will launch a scheme for the development of students from Scheduled Castes.

- Scheme for Residential Education for Students in High Schools in Targeted Areas (SRESHTA) will be launched by the Government.
- >>> The scheme will be launched for socioeconomic upliftment and overall development of Scheduled Castes students.
- >>> The scheme will be inaugurated on Dr. B R Ambedkar's Mahaparinirvan Diwas on December 6th.
- >>> The scheme will also help to reduce SC students' dropout rates from 9th to 12th grades.

#### 3. Bhubaneswar will host a two-day regional conference on 'Replication of Good Governance Practices.'

- The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), in partnership with the Government of Odisha, will hold a semi-virtual Regional Conference in Bhubaneswar on December 3-4, 2021.
- >>> The Conference will be organized with the theme: "Replication of Good Governance Practices."
- >>> The Conference's major aim is to bring national and state level public administration organizations on the same platform.

- >>> In a semi-virtual format, delegates from 14 states in India's North-Eastern and Eastern regions will attend the conference.

#### 4. Vice Admiral Biswajit Dasgupta takes charge as Flag Officer Commanding-in-Chief (FOC-in-C), Eastern Naval Command.

- > Vice Admiral Biswajit Dasgupta has taken charge as Flag Officer Commandingin-Chief (FOC-in-C), Eastern Naval Command on 01 December 2021.
- >>> Vice Adm Biswajit Dasgupta is an alumnus of National Defence Academy. He was commissioned into the Indian Navy in 1985.
- >>> He is a recipient of the Ati Vishisht Seva Medal and Vishisht Seva Medal for distinguished service.
- >> He was also awarded the Yudh Seva Medal for coordinating evacuation operations from strife-torn Yemen in 2015 under Operation Raahat.
- >>> He was the Chief of Staff, Eastern Naval Command since Jun 2020.
- Eastern Naval Command is one of three commands of Indian Navy. It is headquartered in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

# 5. PM Modi inaugurated and laid foundation stone of many projects in Dehradun.

- >>> Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid foundation stones and inaugurate multiple projects in Dehradun.
- >> He inaugurated project worth 18 thousand crore rupees to improve road infrastructure and increase tourism in the region.
- > He also laid the foundation stone of the project related to the development of water supply, road and drainage system in Dehradun.
- The infrastructural project also includes the Delhi-Dehradun Economic Corridor, which will be built at a cost of around eight thousand 300 crore rupees.
- > Delhi-Dehradun Corridor will reduce the travel time from Delhi to Dehradun from six hours to around 2.5 hours. It will have Asia's largest wildlife elevated corridor.
- A bridge across the River Ganga next to the Lakshman Jhula will be also constructed. It will also have a glass deck for walking and it will also allow light weight vehicles to move.
- >> A greenfield alignment project connecting Halgoa, Saharanpur, Haridwar will be constructed.
- The Haridwar Ring Road Project from Manoharpur to Kangri will be constructed at a cost of over 16 hundred crore rupees. The 120 Mega Watt Vyasi Hydroelectric Project will be built over River Yamuna.

#### 6. Anju Bobby George wins World Athletics Women of year award.

>>> Indian Athlete Anju Bobby George has been awarded with the World Athletics Women of year award.

- She had won the bronze medal in the long jump at the 2003 World Championships in Athletics in Paris.
- She is the first Indian athlete to win a medal in the World Championship with a jump of 6.70m. She also wins the gold medal at the IAAF World Athletics Final.
- She received the Woman of the Year award at the World Athletics Awards for her efforts in inspiring women to make career in sports.
- She was awarded with the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna award in 2004 and the Arjun award in 2003.
- She is the Chairperson of TOPS (Target Olympic Podium Scheme) and is also the Executive member of the Khelo India project.

#### 7. Sanjay Dutt appointed as Brand Ambassador of '50 Years of Arunachal Pradesh' celebration.

- Arunachal Pradesh government appoints Sanjay Dutt as Brand Ambassador of '50 Years of Arunachal Pradesh' celebration.
- Sanjay Dutt started media campaign for the month-long celebrations, from 20th January to 20th February, 2022.
- >>> The celebrations will start from 20th January 2022 at Ziro in Lower Subansiri district.
- >>> It will cover all the five river basins of the state after which the first districts were named viz, Kameng, Subansiri, Siang, Lohit and Tirap.
- The celebration will end on 20th February 2022 at Itanagar during the 36th Statehood Day celebrations.
- Filmmaker Rahul Mittra has been appointed as brand advisor on the occasion of golden jubilee celebrations, marking 50th year of naming of state.
- Arunachal Pradesh was erstwhile known as North Eastern Frontier Agency. It came into existence as a Union Territory on 20th January 1972. It became full-fledged state of India on 20 February 1987.

- >>> The pair of Mairaj Ahmad and Areeba Khan won the Mixed Skeet Team title in Patiala.
- > In Delhi's Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Range, Punjab's Vijayveer Sidhu won gold in the 25-metre Standard Pistol event.

### 9. Earth Station of Doordarshan Kendra to be inaugurated in Gorakhpur.

> Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting Anurag Singh Thakur will inaugurate the Earth Station of Doordarshan Kendra in Gorakhpur.

- >>> On this occasion, three FM stations of All India Radio will be also inaugurated. It will be the second earth station of Doordarshan in Uttar Pradesh.
- This Earth Station will help in telecasting programmes generated at the local level through DTH across the world. It will be a boon for the Bhojpuri artists.
- >>> Three FM stations of All India Radio will be inaugurated virtually at Etawah, Lakhimpur Kheri, and Bahraich districts.

- ✓ It was established in 1936. It is a division of Prasar Bharati.
- ✓ Its motto is 'Bahujan Hitaya: Bahujan Sukhaya'. It is officially known as Akashvani.

### 10. India has completed its ambitious goal of generating 40% of its installed electrical capacity from non-fossil fuels.

- The country's total installed non-fossil fuel-based capacity is 156.83 Giga Watts.
- ▶ Last month, the country has reached this goal, well ahead of the target year set at the Conference of the Parties-21 in France.
- ▶ India had promised to obtain 40% of its installed electrical capacity from nonfossil energy sources by 2030 as part of its Nationally Determined Contributions.
- Today, the country's installed renewable energy capacity is 150.05 Giga Watts, while nuclear energy-based installed electrical capacity is 6.78 Giga Watts.
- This takes the overall non-fossil energy capacity installed to 156.83 Giga Watts, accounting for 40.1 percent of the total installed electrical capacity of over 390 Giga Watts.

- The nation is celebrating the 137th birth anniversary of Dr. Rajendra Prasad and hailing him as a person of unique talent who made a distinguished contribution to the freedom movement.
- >> Rajendra Prasad, who was born in Bihar, is the first Indian president to have served on two terms.
- Rajendra Prasad was a real Gandhian, as well as a visionary statesman, skilled lawyer, fervent patriot, and devout nationalist.

## 13. The Kamaladevi Chattopadhyay NIF Book Prize 2021 has been given to Dinyar Patel's biography of Dadabhai Naoroji.

- The prestigious Kamaladevi Chattopadhyay NIF Book Prize 2021 has been given to the author Dinyar Patel for his book "Naoroji: Pioneer of Indian Nationalism".
- >>> It is a biography of one of the most significant figures in modern Indian history, Dadabhai Naoroji.
- The winner has been announced by the New India Foundation by a shortlist of six books, which covered a variety of themes and subjects.
- $\infty$  The award includes a cash prize of Rs 15 lakh as well as a citation.
- The Kamaladevi Chattopadhyay NIF Book Prize, which was established in 2018, honours high-quality non-fiction literature on modern and contemporary India written by writers of various nationalities and published in the preceding calendar year.
- >>> The award is named after institution-builder Chattopadhyay, who had made substantial contributions to the independence struggle, the women's movement, refugee rehabilitation, and handicraft revitalization.
- Milan Vaishnav (2018), Ornit Shani (2019), and Amit Ahuja and Jairam Ramesh (jointly, 2020) are previous winners of the award.
