














1. India's first Bharat Gaurav tourist train ready to depart, 90% booking done



The country's first Bharat Gaurav tourist train 'Shri Ramayana Yatra', run by Indian Railways, left Delhi's Safdarjung railway station this evening. Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav and Tourism Minister G Kishan Reddy flagged off the tourist train. Nepal's Ambassador to India Dr. Shankar Prasad Sharma and Railway Board Chairman VK Tripathi were also present on the occasion. 533 passengers have made bookings to travel in the train. There are a total of 600 seats in the train, in this way around 90 percent of the bookings were done.

Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav said that it is a matter of pride for India. Today Bharat Gaurav train is leaving from Delhi. It is a route of 8000 kms, it is a journey of 18 days. The train is equipped with modern facilities. Tight security arrangements have been made. Through this visit to the art and culture of India, people will get a chance to understand India. People from different states of the country have come here.

2.India's women's wrestling team has won the Under-17 Asian Championship title in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.



India's women's wrestling team has won the Under-17 Asian Championship title in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan. India topped with 235 points with eight gold, one silver and one bronze medals. Japan finished second with 143 points and Mongolia third with 138 points.

In women's wrestling matches were organized in 5 weight categories. Indian women including Ritika bagged gold in 43 kg, Ahilya Shinde gold in 49 kg, Shiksha in 57 kg, Priya in 73 kg while Pulkit won silver in 65 kg. Apart from this, competitions were also organized in three weight categories of freestyle and Parvinder Singh won gold in 80 kg while Narendra secured silver in 71 kg.

4. Ruchira Kamboj to be the next Permanent Representative of India to UN, to replace TS Tirumurti



Ruchira Kamboj, a 1987 batch Indian Foreign
Service officer has been appointed as the next
Ambassador/Permanent Representative of India to
the United Nations in New York. This information
has been given by the Ministry of External Affairs.
Ruchira is currently India's ambassador to Bhutan,
she will soon take charge of the United Nations.
The extended tenure of TS Tirumurti, the current
Ambassador of India to the United Nations, is
coming to an end soon.

He started his career as Third Secretary from Paris, France. During this time she learned French and soon became the second secretary in the Indian Embassy in France. After this, he oversaw the work of the Western Europe Division as an Under Secretary in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. After this, Ruchira reached Mauritius as the First Secretary (Economy and Commercial). After this she has held several key positions in the Ministry of External Affairs.

5. Dragonfly spotted for the first time in Kerala



Dragonfly enthusiasts have recorded the sighting of a rare dragonfly that was hitherto unseen in Kerala. Afsar Nayakan and Vibhu Vipanchika sighted spiny horntail, Burmagomphus choukulensis joshi, Ogle and Sawant, 2022 (or.) B. choukulensis, during a recent expedition in the Kottiyur forests of Kannur. The species, which is believed to be endemic to the Western Ghats, was discovered in Maharashtra earlier this year.

The recorded discovery from Kottiyur was confirmed by Vinayan P., an odonate expert representing the TNHS Odonata Research Group (TORG) of the Travancore Nature History Society (TNHS). Nair did it.

Researchers Shantanu Joshi, Dattaprasad Sawant and Hemant Ogle had spotted this species from Chaukul in Sindhudurg district of Maharashtra.

Before their discovery, the dragonfly genus
Burmagomphus was represented by three species

– B. kavericus, B. pyramidalis and B. rakhilawi.

While B. Rakhilawi is found throughout the

Western Ghats, B. kavericus is more restricted in distribution. B. pyramidalis is found in the Western Ghats as well as peninsular India. All other species of the genus are found in the western and eastern Himalayas.

The new species can be distinguished from its progenitors by the markings on the lateral thorax and the peculiar shape of the anal appendages, Mr. Nair said.

According to a paper published by TORG last year, 181 Odonata species have been recorded in Kerala.

The version of B. choukulensis would take the count to 182.

6. Launch of an innovative project - Nipuna to boost the skills of workers



The Union Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, launched the National Initiative for Skill Training of Construction Workers, an innovative project named 'Nipun', in New Delhi. (NIPUN) project is an initiative of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs under its flagship scheme of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAI-NULM) to train over 1 lakh construction workers through new skilling and upskilling programmes. And this gives them work opportunities abroad as well. Skilled Project:

The NIPUN project will enable construction workers to find better job opportunities, increase their wages and even for overseas placements, indicating a new eco-system.

The transformative impact of the National Urban Livelihoods Mission has certainly reduced the vulnerability of urban poor households by providing skills and employment opportunities to urban residents, especially the youth.

The implementation of the NIPUN project is divided into three parts, training through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) at construction sites, Plumbing and Infrastructure training through Fresh Skilling by SSC, and International through Industries, Builders and Contractors. Placement.

8. Andhra Pradesh won the Under-19 T20 National Championship for the Deaf.



Andhra Pradesh Deaf won the T20 Championship title by defeating Gujarat Deaf by 5 wickets in the first season. After winning the toss, the bowlers of Andhra Pradesh, who came to bowl first, bowled Gujarat for just 97 runs.

The best batsman of the tournament, Mustakim Kazi, was dismissed for 26 off 22 balls at the hands of Andhra Pradesh's def spinner P Uday Kumar. Man of the match, P Vijaya Bhaskar bowled brilliantly for the Andhra Pradesh def, taking 3 for

11 in his four overs. Also won the man of the series title.

The closing ceremony was held on 19 June 2022 in the presence of members of KFC, Sumit Jain (President, IDCA) and other representatives of the different cricketing community.

9. PM Modi inaugurates new campus of Ambedkar School of Economics



Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday met Dr. B. R. Ambedkar School of Economics (BASE) inaugurated the new campus of the university as well as unveiled a statue of the architect of the Indian Constitution. Prime Minister Modi also dedicated 150 'Technology Hubs' to the program, which have been developed by transforming Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in Karnataka. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister said that Karnataka has a special contribution in India's progress in the world of technology, research and

innovation. "In this context, new technology hubs developed by replacing ITIs will provide skilling opportunities to the youth and generate employment opportunities," he said. These 'technology hubs' have been developed at a cost of over Rs 4,700 crore and are supported by several industrial partners. Its objective is to create skilled workforce to meet the needs of the industries. The state government contributed Rs 657 crore out of the total cost while Tata Technologies Limited (TTL) and its industry partners contributed Rs 4,080 crore. The state has spent an additional Rs 220 crore to set up specialized workshops and technology laboratories in these 150 ITIs.
