

1. What is the 'Family Doctor Project' of Andhra Pradesh?



Andhra Pradesh State Government has decided to implement "Family Doctor Project" on a pilot basis in Padmanabham mandal of Visakhapatnam district. The project is likely to be implemented from 15 August 2022. This project will be taken up with an aim to improve health services among the rural population.

As a part of the "Family Doctor Project", a primary health center (PHC) doctor will be made available to look after the health needs of the people in the ward and the village secretariat.

Doctors will provide patient services for the residents of the ward from 9 am to 12.30 pm. Lunch break will be given from 12.30 pm to 1.30 pm.

The same doctors will again visit patients who are critically ill and need antenatal and postpartum care from 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm.

Prior to the doctor's visit, ANMs, ASHA workers and Mid-Level Health Providers (MLHPs) will go door-to-door to identify those who require the services of a doctor.

The detailed list will be submitted by them to the doctor. After this the doctors of PHC will visit these houses and provide health services.

2. Krishan Lal Panwar inaugurated the 69th Senior National Men's Kabaddi Championship



The four-day 69th Senior National Men's Kabaddi competition going on in New Anaj Mandi of Dadri concluded late on Sunday night. In this competition, the Indian Railways team defeated the Maharashtra team in a tough and exciting match and captured the winner's trophy. Indian Railways has become the champion for the fourth time in a row in the Senior National Competition. In the final match, Indian Railways team scored 38 points and Maharashtra team got only 21 points. Haryana team stood third in the competition. The chief guest of the closing ceremony, District Deputy Commissioner Shyam Lal Poonia, Rajya Sabha member and Amateur Kabaddi Association Haryana President Krishan Lal Panwar General Secretary Kuldeep Dalal Rajasthan Association President Tejashwi Gehlot Dadri President Rajesh Phogat presented the winners, Indian Railways, runners-up Maharashtra and the players of the third place Harvana team. 3. Indermeet Gill appointed as Chief Economist of World Bank, is not special from Delhi



India's economist Indermit Gill has been appointed as the Chief Economist of the World Bank. His appointment will be effective from September 1, 2022. Gill is the second Indian to be appointed to the post. Earlier, Kaushik Basu had held this post from 2012 to 2016. Gill is currently the Vice-

President of Equitable Growth, Finance and Institutions at the World Bank. From 2016 to 2021, he was Professor of Public Policy at Duke University and a Non-Resident Senior Fellow in the Global Economy and Development Program at Brookings Institution.

Gill has been made Chief Economist as well as Senior Vice-President of Development Economics. World Bank President David Malpass said in a statement that Indermeet Gill has extensive experience working with governments on issues such as growth, poverty, institutions, conflict and climate change. The bank will get the benefit of their experiences. He will replace Carmen Reinhart. Gill said that Reinhart has followed a great line and it is an honor for him to follow it.

4. India Designates 5 New Ramsar Sites

India has designated five new wetland sites of international importance, including three wetland sites in Tamil Nadu (Karikili Bird Sanctuary, Pallikaranai Marsh Reserve Forest and Pichavaram Mangrove), one in Mizoram (Pala wetland) and one wetland site in Madhya Pradesh (Sakhya Sagar).) Are included. Thus, the total number of Ramsar sites in the country has increased from 49 to 54. Union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bhupendra Yadav said, "Glad to inform that 5 more Indian wetlands have received Ramsar's recognition as Wetlands of International Importance."

5. Indian Institute of Heritage to be set up as a Deemed University



The Indian Heritage Institute will soon be set up as a Deemed University to provide higher education and research in areas related to Indian heritage and its conservation. Culture and Tourism Minister G. Kishan Reddy gave this information in Lok Sabha today. He said that the Indian Heritage Institute would be established at Noida, Gautam Budh Nagar in Uttar Pradesh. The institute will offer postgraduate and research degrees in subjects such as art history, conservation, museology, archival studies, archaeology, preventive conservation. Sri Reddy also informed that the Indian Heritage Institute is meant to meet the human resource needs in the entire cultural sector. It is known that the new education policy envisages the inclusion of culture as an integral part of the educational curriculum. Sri Reddy also said that the opening of this institute would encourage the study of museology at a higher level.

Responding to a supplementary question, Minister of State for Culture, Arjun Ram Meghwal informed that Diploma and Certificate courses will also be offered specifically under History of Art, Museums and Conservation to improve the human resource needs at the grassroots level. Will be able

The first International Film Festival was held in September 2019 in Jammu, the winter capital of the Union Territory. Due to Kovid-19, this festival could not be organized for two years.

8. IIT Kanpur launches program called 'Nirman'



The Startup Incubation and Innovation Center (SIIC) at IIT Kanpur has launched the "Building" accelerator program supported by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India. The program will focus on manufacturing startups engaged in healthcare and agriculture domains to help them meet the challenges from their prototype-to-market journey.
