1. SEBI approves Sachin Bansal's Navi Tech to bring IPO



The country's IPO market is out. One after the other, many companies are bringing their initial public offering ie IPO. Now Flipkart co-founder Sachin Bansal-led financial services company Navi Technologies is also preparing to bring an IPO. The company has filed preliminary documents with the market regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to raise Rs 3,350 crore through IPO. According to the draft red herring prospectus ie DRHP, the proposed IPO will be a completely new issue. And there is no offer for sale (OFS) in it. Navi Technologies is planning to raise Rs 3,350 crore from the market.

2. Japan India Maritime Exercise 2022 begins in Bay of Bengal



Ignoring China's concerns, India called Japan and conducted naval exercises in the Bay of Bengal. In fact, to increase operational understanding, the navies of India and Japan are conducting military exercises in the Bay of Bengal. The 6th edition of the 'Japan-India Maritime Exercise' (GIMEX 2022) hosted by the Indian Navy began on 11 September. The Bay of Bengal is located in the middle of South and Southeast Asia. China has been opposing military exercises by any other country here. Recently India and three other Quad countries conducted a major naval exercise with France

in the Bay of Bengal. An Indian Navy spokesperson said the Japan Maritime Self Defense Force (JMSDF) has deployed the helicopter carrier Izumo and the guided missile destroyer Takanami for the exercise. The spokesperson said that the Indian Navy is represented by the multi-role stealth frigate 'Sahyadri' and the anti-submarine frigate. Warships 'Kadmat' and 'Kavaratti' are doing that. Apart from this, guided missile destroyer 'Ranvijay', fleet tanker 'Jyoti', offshore patrol vessel 'Sukanya', submarines, MiG-29K fighters, long-range maritime Patrol aircraft etc. are taking part in this exercise. This edition marks the 10th anniversary of Jimex, which debuted in Japan in 2012.

3. Collaborates with Meta to Promote XR Technology Startups



Under an agreement signed between the startup arm of the Ministry of Information Technology (IT) MeitY Startup Hub and Facebook's parent firm Meta, the two will jointly promote the 'extended reality startup ecosystem' in India. Speaking on the occasion, Minister of State for Electronics & IT Rajiv Chandrashekhar said that the Extended Reality (XR) startup program is a milestone in the field of metaverse, which is an important part of the emerging future of the Internet. MeitY Startup Hub (MSH), an initiative of the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), and META have joined hands to promote XR technology startups in India, under which a catalytic program will be launched. The XR Startup Program is supported by META's XR Program and Research Fund.

4. Prime Minister Narendra Modi to attend SCO Summit in Samarkand, Uzbekistan on 15-16 September

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Uzbekistan on September 15-16 to attend the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) summit. Chinese President Xi Jinping will also attend this meeting. Apart from this, Russian President Vladimir Putin and Pakistani Prime Minister Shahbaz Sharif are expected to attend. This summit is being organized in Samarkand, Uzbekistan. According to the information so far, in this meeting, Prime Minister Modi's Pakistani Prime Minister Shahbaz Sharif, Chinese President Xi Jinping and Russian President Vladimir Putin are likely to meet. PM Modi will attend the 22nd meeting of the Council of Heads of State of the SCO. However, it is not yet confirmed whether the Prime Minister will hold bilateral talks with these leaders. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's meeting with the President of China took place at the BRICS Summit 2019. This summit is taking place at a time when Russia-Ukraine and China-Taiwan tensions are being seen. Apart from this, this summit is also important for India because this time India will assume the rotational presidency of SCO. That is, India will chair this group for 1 year till September 2023. Apart from this, the next summit is likely to be held in India in which the leaders of China, Russia and Pakistan will be involved.

5. Likith YP Won Bronze Medal In World Skill Competition 2022



Likith YP has won Bronze Medal in 'Skill of Prototype Modeling WorldSkill Competition 2022' (WSC2022).

Likith completed his Diploma in Mechatronics from Toyota Technical Training Institute and was training for this competition since January 2022. She has also won India's National Skills Competition "IndiaSkills 2021" in Prototype Modeling Skills. They have been trained by Toyota India specialist Bhaskar Singh, who is also the chief expert on prototype modeling skills at the World Skills International Forum. The WorldSkills Competition is an international competition for skilled youth among the member countries of WorldSkills International. Earlier the World Skills Competition was to be held in Shanghai, but due to the outbreak of Kovid there, it was moved to 15 countries to be held over a period of 2 months. The prototype modeling skills competition was the first phase beginning of WSC 2022 which has been organized at Bern, Switzerland from 7-10 September 2022. National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) Organizing Competition and International Skill Competition. It is an implementing body for training youth to represent the country.

7. Mobile recharge will be valid for 30 days instead of 28, TRAI has given instructions

The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has taken a major decision in favor of prepaid mobile customers. TRAI on Monday directed all telecom companies to give the validity of mobile recharge 30 days instead of 28 days. Along with this, the telecom company will now have to bring a special voucher, a combo voucher with the validity of the whole month in its plan. TRAI had issued these instructions even seven months ago, but the telecom companies did not follow it. Therefore, TRAI has again given these instructions to all the telecom companies. Let us tell you that the existing plans of telecom companies have a validity of 28 days, Due to which customers have to do monthly recharge 13 times in a year. After this decision of TRAI, it is believed that the number of recharges done by the customers in a year will come down. By doing this, customers will save money for one month's extra recharge. TRAI has issued a notification for telecom companies. According to this notification, all telecom service providers will have to bring at least one plan voucher, one special tariff voucher and one combo voucher with a validity of 30 days. Apart from this, companies have been asked to comply with the order of the rules within 60 days from the date of notification. 8. Senior Advocate Mukul Rohatgi to be the next Attorney General of India



Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi is set to become the Attorney General of India again. He is set to begin his second term as the country's highest law officer from October 1. Current Attorney General K.K. Venugopal's term ends on September 30. The 91-year-old Venugopal was appointed as the country's top law officer on June 30, 2017. Sources said that Rohatgi is one of the lawyers of the top court of the country. He has given his consent to take over the top post. He was first appointed Attorney General in 2014 for a three-year term. Venugopal had recently said that he cannot continue as the top law officer after the completion of his current term. The Attorney General also has the right to be heard in all the courts of the country. In June this year, Venugopal's tenure was extended by the central government for three months. The government had requested him to continue in this post for three more months. He agreed to remain in this post till 30 September so that the government could find a new face. Now 67-year-old Rohatgi will start his second term as Attorney General from October 1. He has also served as the Additional Solicitor General.
