

1. The country 's first coaching hub will be developed in Jaipur



The State Government has taken an important initiative in the direction of providing better facilities to the youth of the state for preparation of competitive examinations and placement of coaching institutes in a systematic manner. With the visionary thinking of Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, the country's first coaching hub is being made by Rajasthan Housing Board, Jaipur, in which all modern facilities will be available to the students. Housing Board Commissioner Pawan Arora informed that the country's first coaching hub is being developed in a planned manner on 65 thousand square meters of land in Pratap Nagar, Jaipur. In this coaching hub, being built at a cost of about Rs 228 crore, 5 institutional blocks and 90 commercial complexes are being built in the first phase. Along with this, development works like boundary wall, internal road etc. are being done. So far, works worth about Rs 100 crore have been completed. This is a unique project of the state government, Through which all the educational facilities will be available to the students of the country and the state in a single campus. 5. Samantha Cristoforetti becomes first European woman to command the International Space Station



She will be accompanied by astronaut Samantha Cristoforetti as her commander with Crew-5, leaving in October this year. In doing so, she would become the first European woman to hold the position. Russian Astronaut Oleg Artemyev, currently a member of the Expedition-67 crew, is the commander of the ISS. After announcing his name, Samantha, 45, said, "I am humbled by my appointment to the rank of commander. A lot in space and in orbit on Earth." I am curious to know about the experience I have to lead a capable team. Since arriving at the ISS in April this year, Samantha has been leading the US segment there. This includes European, Canadian, Japanese and American projects include. After taking command,

Samantha of Italy will become the 5th European Commander of the ISS. Prior to this, Frank de Winn, Alexander Gerst, Luca Parmitano and Thomas Pesquet of European countries have been commanders of the space station.

6. 'Tourism Parv' will start in Mumbai from today



In the country's financial capital Mumbai, the apex body of Hindi-speaking people, North Bharatiya Sangh Bhavan will get the status of a tourist destination. Also, Law College and Development Center will be opened in the premises of the building. State Tourism, Skill Development and Women and Child Development Minister Mangal Prabhat Lodha on Tuesday announced that Hindi-speaking MLA Mangal Prabhat Lodha has been made a cabinet minister in the Shinde-Fadnavis government after the change of power in Maharashtra. On Tuesday, a grand felicitation program was organized for him by Santosh RN Singh, president of the North Indian Association based in Bandra East. During this, Lodha said that Hindi speakers have made their place in Mumbai through their hard work. Taking a dig at a big North Indian leader who came from Congress to BJP, he advised Hindi speaking leaders not to do politics among themselves. Lodha said that the way the construction of Ram temple in Ayodhya started with blood and sweat, Similarly, due to the efforts of Late RN Singh, the North Indian Sangh Bhawan has come up. He said that the demand of Santosh Singh to open a law college

in Sangh Bhawan would be fulfilled. Lodha suggested that a statue of the personalities who contributed to the development of Mumbai be installed in the Sangh Bhavan, which would make it easier to declare the Sangh Bhavan as a tourist centre.

7. Evidence of floods found on Mars



Researchers from Jackson State University, Cornell University and the University of Hawaii are currently analyzing the data sent by the Mars Curiosity Rover sent to Mars in collaboration with NASA. On analyzing this data, it was found that there was a terrible flood on Mars 400 million years ago. Evidence of this has been found in the Gale Crater of Mars. There must have been a lot of ice here 400 million years ago. Only then an asteroid would have fallen on it. The energy and heat from his collision would have melted the ice and it would have taken the form of a terrible flood. After examining the data from Curiosity, scientists found that the depth of this horrific flood water in Gale Crater was about 78 feet. But when the waves arose, they were devastating. A 32 feet high wave was rising every second.

8. R Venkataramani will be the new Attorney General of the country



Senior advocate R Venkataramani has been appointed as the new Attorney General of India for a period of three years. The term of the current Attorney General is ending soon. Mukul Rohatgi had also recently turned down the government's offer to take up the post. After this, now R Venkataramani has been appointed to this post. Venugopal's term ends on September 30. He served as the top law officer of the Center for five years. The central government had offered 67year-old Mukul Rohatgi to become the Attorney General again but he rejected it. At the end of June this year, AG Venugopal's tenure was extended by three months. This extension is set to expire on 30 September. Senior advocate Makul Rohatgi had turned down the government's offer to return as Attorney General. Rohatgi stepped down as Attorney General in June 2017. He was succeeded by KK Venugopal.
