1. Indian Army and Air Force conduct joint exercise ' Gagan Strike ' in Punjab



Showcasing the valor and prowess of the Indian Armed Forces, Kharga Corps conducted the Gagan Strike, a joint exercise between the Indian Army and the Indian Air Force. The exercise was conducted over a period of four days. The exercise recognized Apache 64E and Advanced Light Helicopter WSI as powerful weapon delivery platforms. With the addition of these machines to ground operations, the combat superiority of our forces has also increased. In this exercise the maneuver is being employed as an aerial adjunct in support of the ground forces practicing to destroy enemy strongholds, which carry out deep penetration and thus create a difficult position for the enemy. . 4. Indian Navy launches third stealth frigate 'Taragiri' of Project 17A

7. Asia Cup 2022 Final: Sri Lanka won by 23 runs



Sri Lanka's team has become the Asia Cup champion for the sixth time. Sri Lankan team defeated Pakistan by 23 runs in the final. Pakistan captain Babar Azam won the toss and decided to bowl first. Batting first, Sri Lanka scored 170 runs for the loss of six wickets in 20 overs. Bhanuka Rajapaksa played an unbeaten innings of 71 runs. Sri Lanka's team bowled out Pakistan for 147 runs in 20 overs. For Pakistan, Mohammad Rizwan scored 55 runs in 49 balls. With this defeat, Pakistan's dream of winning the Asia Cup for the third time was shattered. Pramod Madushan took 4 and Wanindu Hasaranga 3 wickets for Sri Lanka. Sri Lanka first won the Asia Cup title in the year 1986. This was followed by 1997, 2004, 2008, The team has won the title in 2014 and now in 2022. India has won this title the maximum number of times. Sri Lanka are now just one title away from them. This is the first time since April 2014 that Sri Lanka have won five consecutive T20Is. Earlier, the team had won five consecutive T20 matches in the T20 World Cup played in Bangladesh in 2014.

8. India-Bangladesh Relations, a Model for Bilateral Relations

Bangladesh's current Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina recently described India-Bangladesh bilateral relations as a 'role model of good neighborhood diplomacy'. Therefore, this statement has come as a claim of long-standing friendship between the two countries for the last five decades. India, on the other hand, was one of the first countries in the world to establish its diplomatic relations with the newly independent nation in December of 1971. Since then, Bangladesh has become India's largest developmental and trading partner in South Asia. This has inspired the two neighboring countries to contribute to each other's economic and social prosperity. Great progress has also been made on issues of security and water sharing, which have largely been a minor thorn in the mutually cordial relations between the two countries. telecommunications, Signed 13 agreements related to culture and other domains. At that time it was seen as a way of acknowledging the Bangladeshi nation to have friendly relations with its land-sharing neighbour. The two countries share about 54 rivers between them, a bilateral Joint River Commission was established between the two in 1972 to maintain mutual connectivity to maximize the benefits of shared river systems.

9. Chief Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari appointed as Chairman of PMLA Appellate Tribunal



The Supreme Court has recommended the name of Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari for the post of Chief Justice of Madras High Court. The collegium held deliberations on 14 December 2021 and 29 January 2022 and recommended 17 names as judges in the Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Odisha High Courts. The collegium also includes Senior Justice UU Lalit and Justice AM Khanwilkar. Justice Bhandari originally belongs to the Rajasthan High Court and is currently appointed as the Acting Chief Justice of the Madras High Court. A statement posted on the Supreme Court website said that the Supreme Court Collegium in its meeting on 14 December 2021/ 29 January 2022 has approved the elevation of Justice Munishwar Nath Bhandari in Madras High Court as Chief Justice of Madras High Court. has recommended. Out of the 17 names sent for judges in the three High Courts, the collegium has decided to recommend the names of seven advocates as judges of the Andhra Pradesh High Court. The Supreme Court Collegium in its meeting held on 29 January 2022 has approved the proposal for promotion of these advocates as judges in the Andhra Pradesh High Court, the statement said.
