3. Thandi and Kadmat beaches get Blue Beach Certification

Minicoy, Thundi Beach and Kadmat Beach - both in Lakshadweep - have made it to the coveted list of 'Blue Beaches', the cleanest beaches in the world.' "This is part of India's tireless journey towards creating a sustainable environment under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji," he tweeted.

At the same time, two more beaches of India included in the 'Blue Beach' list, PM Modi also congratulated and wrote – India's coastal area is very important and people here have passion which is capable of cleaning even more beaches. With this, the number of 'Blue Beaches' in India has increased to 12.

4. Armies of India and America will exercise near China border



Tension has been going on between India and China for a long time, many times the armies of both the countries have come face to face on the border and violent clashes have also been seen. The Chinese army has always been in aggressive mode on the LAC, which is also answered by the Indian Army. Now such news is coming out that China may feel chilly again. The armies of India and America are going to conduct a high-altitude military exercise in Auli, Uttarakhand, close to the LAC this month. This is the 15th time of joint exercise between the armies of India and America.

There is an annual military exercise between the armies of India and America, which is known as 'Yudh Abhyas'. One year this exercise is done in India and one year in America. Last year this exercise was done in Alaska, USA. That is why this year this exercise is going to be held in India. This military exercise will be held from November 15 to December 2.

Now even before the friendship of America and India, China remains stunned, in such a situation, this military exercise is a big message for it. Auli of Uttarakhand is at an altitude of about 10 thousand feet and the Line of Control (LAC) is at a distance of about 100 kilometers from here. The LAC adjacent to Uttarakhand is part of the Central Sector of the Indian Army. Here the Barohti area of the LAC has been disputed between India and China for a long time. During the last two years, when there was

a tussle between the armies of the two countries in eastern Ladakh, there were frequent reports of increasing military activities of China in this area too. This is the reason why the military exercise between India and America in the month of October becomes very important.

5. Neral-Matheran top train resumes in Maharashtra



In the coming time, soon you will be able to travel from Neral to Matheran by local train (Mumbai Local Train). According to the information received, the Central Railway (CR) is planning to start a local train-like facility between Neral and Matheran. Railway has also started work in this direction. Matheran is a small hill station located 100 km from Mumbai. According to media reports, the Central Railway is in talks with the manufacturer to manufacture engineless multi-unit trains like the Mumbai local train for the narrow-gauge section Neral to Matheran. It is being told that talks are going on with the Integral Coach Factory (ICF) of the Railways for a newly designed diesel-electric powered multiple unit (DEMU) type self-propelled train.

It is worth noting that the mini train is the main center of attraction among the tourists in Matheran. Matheran's hugely popular mini train has returned to the tracks from October 22 ahead of the Diwali holidays. In fact, this 20km-long narrow gauge line was damaged by heavy rains during the monsoon in August 2019 and was closed since then.

According to Central Railway, daily two down train service is being operated between Neral-Matheran and two up service between Matheran-Neral. Neral is situated at the foothills of the Matheran Mountains and is connected to Mumbai by the suburban local train network of the Central Railway.

6. Sangeeta Verma becomes Acting Chairperson of Competition Commission of India

8. Satyajit Ray's 'Pather Panchali' declared best Indian film of all time by International Federation of Film Critics



One of the world's greatest filmmakers, Satyajit Ray's iconic feature film 'Pather Panchali' has been declared the best Indian film of all time by the International Federation of Film Critics (FIPRESSI). This historical film of Indian cinema, which came in 1955, was at the forefront of the competition and secured the first position in the list of Top 10. This new milestone of 'Pather Panchali' was announced after the voting conducted by FIPRESCI. A committee of 30 members was involved in the voting.

"Pather Panchali" was filmmaker Satyajit Ray's directorial debut, based on the 1929 novel of the same name written by Vibhutibhushan Bandyopadhyay. Talking about the star cast of the film, "Pather Panchali" starred Subir Banerjee, Kanu Banerjee, Karuna Banerjee, Uma Dasgupta, Pinaki Sengupta and Chunibala Devi. Apart from "Pather Panchali", the films that are included in the FIPRESCI list are Ritwik Ghatak's 1960 play "Meghe Dhaka Tara" (Bengali), Mrinal Sen's 1969 play "Bhuvan Shome" (Hindi), Gopalakrishnan's Adoor 1981 play "Elippathayam" (Malayalam) and Girish 1977 "Ghathasraddha" Kasaravalli's film (Kannada). Apart from these, MS Sathyu's 1973 film "Garm Hawa" (Hindi), Satyajit Ray's 1964 film "Charulata" (Bengali), Shyam Benegal's 1974 film "Ankur" (Hindi), Guru Dutt's 1954 film "Pyaasa" " (Hindi) and the 1975 blockbuster "Sholay" (Hindi) directed by Ramesh Sippy.
