1. Indian Air Force will celebrate its 90th Raising Day today



The Indian Air Force (IAF) was established before independence on 8 October 1932. Since then Air Force Day is celebrated every year on 8 October. Raising Day is the occasion when the Indian Air Force displays its might.

For the first time in the history of the Air Force, Air Force Day is being celebrated outside Delhi in Chandigarh, and this is the highlight of the IAF this year. Today the audience will get to see the might of the Air Force in the sky of the famous Sukna Lake of Chandigarh. The program started at 9 in the morning.

The country's President Draupadi Murmu is the chief guest of today's program. Also Defense Minister Rajnath Singh is also present there. Before the air show, there will be a formal parade at the Air Force base today. Air Chief Marshal VR Choudhary will oversee the parade. On this occasion, the Chief of Air Staff will also unveil a new format of combat uniform for the Air Force personnel on the occasion.

There will also be a fly past of two formations of the helicopter at the air base during the parade. Along with this, gallantry medals will also be given to the airmen. The Chief of Air Staff will also release the new Combat Uniform of the Air Force during this period. Just like this year the new uniform of the army was issued on Army Day.

According to the Air Force, this year the flypast will run for two hours. It will start from 2.45 pm and will run till 4.44 pm. About 80 military aircraft and helicopters will take part in the flypast. Light Combat Helicopters (LCH) Prachanda, Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas, Sukhoi, MiG-29, Jaguar, Rafale, IL-76, C-130J, Hawk, Light Helicopters Dhruv, Chinook, Apache and Mi-17 Fly in Helicopters Past will join.

Let us tell you that before the independence of India, the Air Force was called Royal Indian Air Force (RIAF). The Indian Air Force was established on 8 October 1932. After independence, the word "Royal" was dropped from the name of the Air Force to just Indian Air Force (IAF).

2. For the first time in Uttar Pradesh, 3 women PAC battalions were formed



On the instructions of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, the women's safety and empowerment campaign Mission Shakti was started in the state. Under this, 20 percent of the police force of the state was reserved for the appointment of women, so that women could be made self-reliant with security.

Three Provincial Sashastra Seema Bal (PAC) women battalions are being established in the name of brave and courageous women in the state. These three battalions are being named after Rani Avantibai Lodhi, Uday Devi and Jhalkari Bai, who sacrificed their lives in the freedom struggle of India. This battalion is being established at Badaun, Lucknow and Gorakhpur. The process of posting 1262 posts in one women battalion of PAC is going on.

So far, 3,98,686 complaints have been received through the Women Help Desk, out of which 3,89417 complaints have been resolved. Similarly, a total of 47,855 cases have been registered against 1,14,269 accused through the help desk. Of these, 81,011 criminals have been arrested. Also, in

3,55,519 cases, the senior officers of the police stations took the feedback of women.

3. Delhi Government Launches Anti-Dust Campaign



Anti dust campaign will run from 6th October to 6th November. Delhi Environment Minister Gopal Rai said that it is necessary to implement 14 antidust rules related to construction at construction sites. 586 teams have been formed under the anti dust campaign. This includes 33 teams of DPCC. According to the NGT guidelines, a fine ranging from Rs 10,000 to Rs 5 lakh will be imposed for violation of rules at construction sites.

He informed that 586 teams have been formed for anti dust campaign. Teams from 12 related departments are also involved in this. These teams include 33 teams of DPCC (Delhi Pollution Control Committee), 165 teams of Revenue Department, 300 of MCD, 20 of DSIIDC, 14 of Delhi Jal Board, 33 of DDA, 3 of Delhi Metro, 6 of CPWD, 6 of PWD., 1 team from NDMC, 4 from Delhi Cantt Board and 1 team from NHAI. These teams will regularly visit the construction sites and ensure that the construction guidelines are followed there. It is necessary to implement 14-point rules on construction sites, for which the anti-dust campaign has started from Thursday

4. RBI Launches New Advanced Monitoring System 'Daksh'



Reserve Bank of India Governor Shaktikanta Das on Thursday launched the Advance Supervisory Monitoring System 'DAKSH' (DAKSH). This is expected to strengthen the monitoring process of RBI.

RBI said in a statement that it has been taking several steps to strengthen the monitoring activities and 'Daksh' is a new link in this. "Daksh is a web-based end-to-end workflow application through which RBI will be able to monitor entities like banks and NBFCs in a more focused manner," the Reserve Bank said.

This 'Supertech' application of RBI will enable seamless communication, inspection planning and execution, cyber incident reporting and analysis through a single platform that enables secure access anywhere and anytime. The Reserve Bank said that this monitoring system will work efficiently and effectively as per its name.

RBI plans to extensively use Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) to analyze its extensive database and improve regulatory oversight over banks and NBFCs. RBI will also recruit external experts for this. Although RBI is still using artificial intelligence and machine learning technology, but now there is an attempt to make it more comprehensive so that the supervision department in the central bank can be made more advanced.

5. Belarusian human rights activist, Russian and Ukrainian organization honored with Nobel Peace Prize 2022



The announcement of the peace prize in Norway's capital Oslo coincided with the 70th birthday of Russian President Vladimir Putin, who is believed to be responsible for inflicting war on Ukraine. The Nobel Committee has also done the work of conveying a message to Putin through the Peace Prize.

The much-awaited Nobel Peace Prizes were announced on Friday. The award this year went to the world's most disturbed region, the winners of which have been jailed Belarusian human rights activist Ales Bilyatsky, Russian human rights organization 'Memorial' and Ukrainian organization 'Center for Civil Liberties'.

The announcement of the peace prize in Norway's capital Oslo coincided with the 70th birthday of Russian President Vladimir Putin, who is believed to be responsible for inflicting war on Ukraine. The Nobel Committee has also done the work of conveying a message to Putin through the Peace Prize. Announcing the three names, Norwegian Nobel Committee chair Berit Rijs-Andersen said, "This year's peace prize has been given to honor advocates of human rights, democracy and peaceful coexistence in neighboring Belarus, Russia and Ukraine."

These winners have revived and honored Alfred Nobel's vision of peace and fraternity among nations through their continued efforts in favor of humanitarian values, anti-militarism and the law, he said. It is needed the most in the world today.

6. Preparations in full swing for the annual Srimanotsavam in Vizianagaram in Andhra Pradesh



The preparations for the annual Srimanotsavam are in full swing at Vizianagaram in Andhra Pradesh. The festival will be held on October 11. It is the main festival of Sripayadithalli Ammavari Jatara, the main deity of Vizianagaram city. This major tribal folk festival of North Coastal Andhra Pradesh was being celebrated in a simple manner for the last two years due to the Corona pandemic. The traditional Srimanotsavam Jatara is celebrated every year on the first Tuesday after Dussehra. It is also known as Srimanu Panduga. Four to five lakh devotees from Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Chhattisgarh are expected to participate in the festival.

7. First of its kind Bird Festival begins in Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir



The first of its kind bird festival began yesterday in Anantnag district of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. It is being organized by J&K Tourism Department in association with Sanctuary Prakriti Pratishthan. J&K Tourism Secretary Sarmad Hafeez inaugurated the festival. Addressing the nature and bird lovers, he said that the partnership of the department with the Sanctuary Prakriti Pratishthan would give a boost to tourism in Kashmir and also reveal new and unexplored aspects of the tourism sector. The opening ceremony of the six-day bird

festival was attended by nature and bird lovers from Jammu and Kashmir and across the country.

8. Pooja Patel became the first athlete to win a gold medal in Yogasana at the 36th National Games



In the 36th National Games, Gujarat's Pooja Patel has become the first player to win gold in Yogasan. This time the five new sports which have been included in the National Games, one is Yogasan. Among other events, Maharashtra today won the gold medal in women's diving in one meter springboard event. In women's hockey, Haryana has reached the semi-finals by defeating Karnataka by six zeros. West Bengal beat Karnataka 1-3 in Purupu Football. But both the teams have reached the semi-finals. The Army has so far topped the medal tally with a total of 96 medals including 41 Gold, 29 Silver and 26 Bronze. Harvana is at the second position with a total of 72 medals including 29 Gold, 23 Silver and 20 Bronze, while Maharashtra is at the third position with a total of 93 medals including 24 Gold, 24 Silver and 45 Bronze.
