

1. Three economists get Nobel Prize 2022 for Economics



Three US economists, including a former Federal Reserve chairman, have been chosen for this year's Nobel Prize in Economics. He has been given this award for "Research on Banks and Financial Crisis". The Nobel Committee at the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences in Stockholm on Monday announced the Nobel Prize in Economics to Ben S. Bernanke, Douglas W. Diamond and Philipp H. Diebwig. Ben S. Bernanke is the former chairman of the US central bank Federal Reserve. The award carries a cash prize of 10 million Swedish kronor (approximately nine million US dollars). The award will be presented on 10 December.

The Nobel Committee stated that their research explained "why it is important to avoid a bank collapse." laid the foundation of Bernanke, 68, is currently with The Brookings Institution in Washington, DC. He researched the Great Depression of the 1930s and pointed out how dangerous a bank could be if panic-stricken savers pulled out their deposits. In their research, Diamond, 68, of the University of Chicago and 67-year-old Diabwig, of Washington University in St. Louis, described how government guarantees on deposits could prevent a financial crisis from escalating.

2. 9 - member task force constituted to monitor foreign cheetahs



The Union Environment Ministry has constituted a nine-member task force to monitor the settlement of cheetahs in the Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh. In his monthly radio broadcast 'Mann Ki Baat' last month, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had said the task force would decide when people can see cheetahs in the national park. The ministry said in a statement that the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) will facilitate the functioning of the "Cheetah Task Force"

and will provide all necessary assistance. The task force constituted for a period of two years may constitute a sub-committee to regularly visit the field of cheetahs.

Madhya Pradesh's National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) member Abhilash Khandekar and Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (APCCF) K Subharanjan Sen. Prime Minister Modi released the first group of eight cheetahs brought from Namibia at Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh on his birthday on September 17. In the year 1952, 70 years after the cheetahs were declared extinct in India, they have returned to the country.

3. Former Defense Minister of India and SP founder Mulayam Singh Yadav passed away



Mulayam Singh Yadav, the patron of the Samajwadi Party, died on Monday morning at around 8:16 am. At the age of 82, he breathed his last at Medanta Hospital in Gurugram, adjacent to Delhi. Mulayam Singh Yadav was a big face in Indian politics and many big stalwarts of politics expressed their condolences on his departure. The Prime Minister of the country, Narendra Modi also expressed his condolences on the death of Mulayam Singh Yadav.

Samajwadi Party founder Mulayam Singh Yadav, who was the Chief Minister of the country's largest state Uttar Pradesh for three times, along with it became MLA 8 times and MP for 7 times. But at the same time, today the country is remembering him not only as the founder of the Samajwadi Party but also as the former Defense Minister of the country because he was the Defense Minister of the country from 1996 to 1998. And during this time, he took such a historic decision for the martyred soldiers of the country, which is going to give comfort to the family of every martyred jawan today. In 1996, Mulayam Singh Yadav was elected to the 11th Lok Sabha from Mainpuri Lok Sabha constituency and at the same time he was made the Defense Minister of the country. And during that tenure, he took a big and important decision for the martyr soldiers of the country, which is an example for humanity today.

If a soldier is martyred today while protecting the borders of the country, then his body is transported with full respect to the family members of his village, this is ensured by the Government of India and the forces. All

arrangements are made to ensure that there is no dearth of any way in this honour, the martyrs who lost their lives for the country. But let us tell you that before the year 1996, if the jawan was martyred, then his body was not handed over to his village or to the relatives, but the jawan was cremated on the border itself, and the soldier's cap, uniform and Other items were given to the relatives with respect.

4. Chhattisgarh will become the country 's largest millet hub, Chief Minister inaugurated



Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel today inaugurated the country's largest millet processing industry established in the state. On this occasion, the Chief Minister visited the processing industry and inquired about the operational activities, marketing and finished products. CM Baghel inaugurated the country's largest millet processing industry established in the state and said on this occasion that Chhattisgarh will become the country's millet hub in the coming times. Today, a small grain unit has been started processing Nathianwagaon, Kanker, which will benefit the farmers cultivating Kodo-Kutki-Ragi as well as women self-help groups. He said that this point established under the Millet Mission is India's highest capacity point. The annual processing capacity of this unit is 10 to 12 thousand tonnes, which would require around 34 to 40 tonnes of Kodo-Kutki-Ragi per day.

CM Baghel said that the raw material for this unit would be made available by the Chhattisgarh State Small Forest Produce Co-operative Federation by

purchasing it directly from the farmers through women self-help groups, for which MoU has been done between Chhattisgarh government and Avani Ayurveda. He said that a cashew processing unit has been set up by the Chhattisgarh government at Bakwand in Bastar, due to which the farmers are getting benefitted there. Today, tamarind processing unit has been established in village Dhuragaon of Lohandiguda block, which will benefit tamarind collectors. IIMR for setting up this unit. MoU has been signed with Hyderabad between Avani Ayurveda Pvt Ltd and District Administration North Bastar Kanker for technical know-how, establishment of high quality seeds, seed bank and training.

5. Pankaj Advani wins 25th world title



Pankaj Advani, India's top player in billiards, defeated compatriot Sourav Kothari 4-0 in the final of the World Championships to win the 25th championship of his career. Advani played a brilliant game and entertained the large number of spectators. Advani had made his intentions clear from the very first frame that he would not give any chance to Kothari. In this 150-plus format, Advani took the first frame with a break of 149. Till then Kothari had not even opened the account.

Kothari is awaiting his maiden IBSF (International Billiards and Snooker Federation) world title. In this 'Best of Seven' final, Advani showed his best from the start and set a unique record of winning billiards national, Asian and world titles for the fifth time in a calendar year. Kothari got a few chances

in the second frame but he could not take advantage of them.

Advani, on the other hand, took a 2-0 lead with the help of a break of 77. After this, Advani's game was further enhanced and he also mesmerized the Malaysian audience with his skills. Advani made the tournament's highest break of 153 in the third frame, just one frame away from the title. The last world championship was played in 2019 due to the corona virus. Advani later said, "Dream come true to defend the title for the fifth time in a row. I am really happy with the way I played and the way I won every billiards tournament this year. I am honored to have won another gold medal for my country at the world level. Advani had earlier won the last world title in Qatar 12 months ago. Then he won the title in the IBSF 6-Red Snooker World Cup.

6. World's tallest Shiva statue built in Rajsamand, Rajasthan



Every particle of Rajasthan has been the center of attraction among the people due to its valor, sacrifice, devotion as well as spiritual and cultural heritage. Now a new chapter like this is going to write its history on the world stage. The inauguration festival of the world's tallest Shiva statue of 369 feet "Vishvas Swaroopam" is being organized from 29 October to 6 November at Nathdwara in Rajsamand district of Rajasthan.

Madan Paliwal, the trustee of Sant Kripa Sanatan Sansthan, told that in this great festival of Mahadev, religious, spiritual, cultural events will be celebrated for 9 days. Murari Bapu's 9-day long Ram Katha will add to this festival and millions of

people from all over the world will be able to witness it. This 369 feet high statue built on the Ganesh Tekri of Nathdwara has been a part of the dream project.

Let us tell you that in this statue built on a hill of 51 bighas, Lord Shiva is seated in the posture of meditation and allad, which is visible from 20 kilometers away. This statue is clearly visible even at night, so that it has been decorated with special lights. The sight of this 9-day long festival will be no less than Mahakumbh. A mass tide of devotees will come on the holy land of Shrinath ji, in such a situation, preparations are going on in full swing. A pandal of about 1.5 lakh square feet is being set up for the event and a pandal of food hall has been set up in about 2 lakh square feet. These pandals are being made with German technology, in which the audience will enjoy listening to the story and bringing food prasad.

Looking at the preparations of the restaurant, it can be understood that 1 lakh people will take food prasad here every day. To deliver the material to the service counter, overhead conveyor technology is being used here, which is amazing in itself. Advance booking of hotels etc. is being done by the people who are part of the event. Not only this, the entire Nathdwara city will glow with light. Electricity decoration and a flourishing view of the city will be visible from the Diwali festival itself. Every day about 50 to 60 thousand devotees will gather to listen to Murari Bapu.

7. India 's first multi - art cultural center will be opened in the name of Nita Ambani in Mumbai



Isha Ambani announced the opening of the Nita Mukesh Ambani Cultural Center (NMACC), an international class multi-art cultural center at Bandra Kurla Complex, Mumbai. This center is dedicated to his mother Nita Mukesh Ambani. Nita Ambani has been playing the role of a mentor in the field of arts for a long time. This cultural center will be the first of its kind in the field of arts. On 31 March 2023, the doors of the NMACC will be opened to the audience. There will be a three-day event to mark the launch. In which many renowned artists of national and international level will exhibit their art.

The 'Nita Mukesh Ambani Cultural Center' (NMACC) will be built at the Jio World Center in Mumbai, the city of dreams. It will have performances and visual arts performances in a three-storey building. The Grand Theatre, The Studio Theater and The Cube Shale will be built for the performing arts. Advance technology will be used in all these. In 'The Grand Theatre', 2 thousand spectators will be able to enjoy programs simultaneously. A four-storey art house spread over 16,000 sq ft will also be launched for the exhibition of Indian and international artists.

8. Chandrayaan - 2 mission detected sodium on the moon

research. Now Chandrayaan-2 of the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has got a big success in space research. Chandrayaan-2 has detected large amounts of sodium for the first time on the lunar surface. This success has also raised hopes of finding the amount of sodium on the moon.

ISRO has said in its statement that the X-ray spectrometer 'Class' on the Chandrayaan-2 orbiter has mapped the abundant sodium on the Moon for the first time. The new findings provide an opportunity to study surface-exosphere interactions on the Moon that will provide further information about our solar system.

The Large Area Soft X-ray Spectrometer or class of Chandrayaan-2, built at the UR Rao Satellite Center, has given clear indications of sodium on the lunar surface, the space agency said in its statement. According to a study, the indications that there is sodium on the Moon may possibly originate from the thin layer of sodium atoms, which are weakly attached to the lunar particles.
