



2. M.C. Mary Kom, P.V. 10 Indian players including Sindhu included in Indian Olympic Association Athletes Commission



Five-time world champion boxer MC Mary Kom, twotime Olympic medalist PV Sindhu and Olympian Shiva Keshavan were elected unopposed as members of the IOA Athletes Commission in the elections held here on Monday. The 10 sportspersons selected in the commission include Tokyo Olympics silver medalist weightlifter Mirabai Chanu, 2012 Olympic bronze medalist Gagan Narang, table tennis player Achanta Sharath Kamal, hockey player Rani Rampal, swordsman Bhavani Devi, rower Bajrang Lal and former shotput player O. P Karhana. Out of the ten players, five are women and all are Olympians. Only Keshavan is a Winter Olympian. Only ten players had filed nominations and Umesh Sinha, Returning Officer of the IOA elections, declared all of them elected unopposed. Shooter Abhinav Bindra, India's first Olympic individual gold medallist, and former hockey captain Sardar Singh will join the commission as members of the International Olympic Committee and the Olympic Council of Asia. Both will have the right to vote. Bindra was elected as a member of the IOC Athletes Commission for eight years in 2018 while Sardar became a member of the OCA Athletes Commission for four years in 2019. 3. Sri Lanka to host U - 19 Men 's T -20 World Cup 2024



The International Cricket Council (ICC) on Sunday (November 13) has announced a major Under-19 cricket tournament to be held from 2024 to 2027. Sri Lanka has got the hosting of the 2024 Under-19 World Cup. At the same time, in 2026, this tournament will be hosted by Zimbabwe and Namibia. The Under-19 Women's T20 World Cup has been jointly hosted by Malaysia and Thailand in 2025. At the same time, in 2027 it will be organized jointly in Bangladesh and Nepal. In its official statement, the ICC said, "The hosts have been selected through a bidding process under the supervision of a Board sub-committee chaired by Martin Snedden. The ICC Board accepted the recommendations of the committee, who, along with the ICC management, thoroughly reviewed each bid." The ICC also confirmed that BCCI secretary Jay Shah will replace Cricket Ireland's Ross McCollum as chairman of the Finance and Commercial Affairs Committee. The qualification route for the 14-team ICC Men's Cricket World Cup 2027 has also been finalised. 10 teams will get direct entry into the tournament. Ten full members will join South Africa and Zimbabwe as hosts. The next eight highest ranked teams in the ICC ODI rankings will qualify for the tournament. The remaining four teams will qualify through the ICC Cricket World Cup Global Qualifier.

4. International Geeta Mahotsav to be organized in Kurukshetra, Haryana



International Gita Mahotsav-2022 will be organized in Haryana from November 19 to December 6 in Kurukshetra along with Saras and Shilp Mela. India's President Draupadi Murmu's arrival in Haryana will also take place on the holy land of Kurukshetra and the main programs will be duly inaugurated by her on November 29, 2022, with Gita Yagya and worship at Brahma Sarovar. Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar gave this information. The Chief Minister said that President Draupadi Murmu will also inaugurate a threeday International Gita Seminar at Kurukshetra University on November 29 itself. Ke Geeta penetrating, Scholars and researchers will present their research papers. Certainly the importance of the message of Gita will spread in the world through this seminar. 5. Indian-origin Amar Singh wins Australian of the Year Award 2023



Indian-origin Sikh volunteer Amar Singh, 41, has been awarded Australia's prestigious honor "2023 New South

Wales Australian of the Year Award" for the aid work done during the Kovid epidemic, floods, drought and forest fires. He has received this honor along with three other people. It has been announced by the Government of New South Wales on 3 November in the "Local Hero" category. Amar Singh has founded "Turbans 4 Australia" in the year 2015 and he is the current chairman of this group. This association is a charity organization that helps people affected by financial hardship, food insecurity, homelessness and natural calamities. A press release issued by Australia's New South Wales government said Mr Singh, a prominent proponent of multiculturalism and social integration, had endured racial slurs in the country because of his beard and turban. According to Singh, 41, religion, language or cultural background should not come in the way of helping others, it is an act of and should be supported without humanity discrimination. 6. G20 Summit begins in Bali, Indonesia



The annual G20 summit, which is being attended by many world leaders, began on Tuesday in Indonesia's Bali province. The conference will discuss the challenges posed by the COVID-19 global pandemic and Russia's

attack on Ukraine. Before the summit officially began, Indonesian President Joko Widodo welcomed Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the venue. The Prime Minister's Office tweeted, "The summit will hold wideranging discussions on ways to deal with important global challenges." Ways to advance sustainable development on our planet will also be discussed. PM Modi also held brief talks with US President Joe Biden and French President Emmanuel Macron. External Affairs Ministry Spokesperson Arindam Bagchi tweeted, "A emerge with Rise up strong. Indonesian President Joko Widodo welcomed Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the G20 Summit. 8. Indo - US joint training exercise ' Yudh Abhyas 2022 ' begins in Uttarakhand



The armies of India and the US began a two-week-long military exercise on Tuesday at a military base in Uttarakhand. It aims to exchange best practices and strategies with the growing defense ties between the two countries. The 'Yudhabhyas' has started amid the 30-month-long standoff between India and China along the border in eastern Ladakh. This exercise is held annually between India and America. Its previous edition will be held in October, 2021 at Joint Base

'Elmendorf Richardson' in Alaska. USA, was done in The 18th edition of the exercise began on Tuesday and will end in the first week of December, officials said. Troops of the Second Brigade of the 11th Airborne Division of the US Army and the Assam Regiment of the Indian Army are participating in the exercise. The Army said the scope of the field training exercise included validation of integrated battle groups, force multipliers, establishment and functioning of surveillance grids, operational logistics and verification of mountain warfare skills. The exercise will involve exchanges and exercises on a wide spectrum of combat skills including combat engineering, employment of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS and counter UAS techniques and information operations). 9. Natasha Musar Elected Slovenia's First Female President

According to officials, Natasa Mooser got 54 per cent of the votes in the 'runoff', while Logar got 46 per cent. Thus Natasa was declared the President.
