



1. Manika Batra became the first Indian woman player to win a medal in the Asian Cup Table Tennis Tournament



Country's number 1 table tennis player Manika Batra has created history in the Asia Cup table tennis tournament. In the match played on Saturday, Manika defeated Hina Hayata by 42 points. With this win, she has become the first Indian woman TT player to win a medal in the Asia Cup Table Tennis tournament. Earlier, she had to face defeat in the semi-finals in the same tournament, after which the match was played for the bronze medal on Saturday, which she won. Earlier, Manika Batra defeated the world number seven player of China in the round of 16 match. Chen Jingtong was shocked and defeated her in a tough match to become the first woman in the country to play in the semi-finals. However, she was shown the way out of the tournament by defeating Japan's Mima Ito in the semi-finals. Mima Ito is the world's number five table tennis player. India's star table tennis player has brought laurels to the country on many platforms. many Manika, who won the gold medal, broke the crown of Singapore and England in the Commonwealth Games. Although Manika Batra could not win a single medal in the Commonwealth Games held in 2022. After the Commonwealth Games, he made several allegations against his coach.

That after reaching Nagpur, Suryakiran's team on Thursday, On November 17, she was supposed to practice as per her schedule. But suddenly on Wednesday morning, in some areas of Nagpur, the sound of high speed planes started echoing in the sky. Rapidly people reached their rooftops and when they looked at the sky, the red colored aircraft of the Suryakiran team were seen hovering in the sky. These aircraft did such an exercise that the citizens looking at the sky kept staring at the sky for the next 1 hour. . One after the other, about half a dozen aircraft were practicing one after the other in the sky. The exercise ended after 1 hour at around 12 noon. The Cuttack Municipal Corporation (CMC) was today awarded the Guinness Book of World Records under the category of most people folding origami figurines together. "1304 was the record to beat and what was achieved here is 2121," he said. A lot of effort

The UK government said that India is the first country to benefit from such a scheme. Let us tell you that this decision has come just a few hours after the meeting between PM Modi and Rishi Sunak.UK Prime Minister's Office Downing Street said in a tweet that today the UKIndia Young Professionals Scheme was confirmed, in which 1830-year-old 3,000 degree-educated Indian nationals were offered visas to come and live and work in the UK for two years.
