



Ikram's term will be two years to fulfill the mandate of former chief Batra, who resigned on July 18.Saif Ahmed was the acting president of the FIH following Batra's resignation from the top post after the Delhi High Court asked him to stop working as the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) chief. Batra, who became FIH president in 2016, resigned from his post in July. He also gave up his International Olympic Committee (IOC) membership which was directly linked to his IOA position. The FIH Executive Board consists of a Chairman; The eight ordinary members - four women and four men - one half are renewed every two years; representatives of athletes; Presidents of Continental Federations; CEO; Any (non-voting) member joining the Executive Board in accordance with Article 7.1(c) of the FIH Statute.

3. Mumbai won the Syed Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy 2022 for the first time



Mumbai won the Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy for the first time by defeating Himachal Pradesh in a thrilling final that lasted till the last over. Vijay Hazare Trophy 2021 winners Himachal Pradesh set Mumbai a target of 144 runs in 20 overs, which Mumbai hit with three balls. Both the teams made it to the final of the Syed Mushtag Ali Trophy for the first time. Invincible throughout the tournament, Himachal dismissed seven Mumbai batsmen while defending 144 runs, but Sarfaraz Khan (37 not out), who was in excellent form in domestic cricket, ensured Mumbai's victory by staying till the end. Sarfaraz also got a lifeline for 19 runs in the 18th over of the innings. Mumbai needed 23 runs in the last two overs and Sarfaraz, taking full advantage of the lifeline, added 17 runs in the 19th over to bring his team closer to victory. After this Tanush Kotian hit a six off the third ball of the last over to give Mumbai the title. Gave it.

The award carries a cash prize of Rs 5,00,000 and a citation.

7. Switzerland sets record for running longest passenger train



Switzerland on Saturday set a record for the world's longest passenger train. There were 100 coaches in this train which has run in the hills of the Alps. The length of this train is about two km. The Ratian Railway (RhB) announced that it has broken the world record for the world's longest passenger train on the 175th anniversary of Switzerland's famous railway system. This train is 1,910 meters. The train is made up of 25 separate multi-unit trains or 100 coaches. RhB chief Renato Fasciatti said at the Blick Daily event, 'For me it is a Swiss perfection. The long, red train has moved slowly up the mountain.' There are freight trains that are even longer. The length of some is more than three km. The longest passenger train ever ran in Switzerland on Saturday. A RhB spokesman said the earlier unofficial record for the longest train was a Belgian train in the 1990s, Which was several hundred

meters long. This record has been made special through the 175th anniversary. When this train was running, its roof was shining like silver in the sun. On it was written Alpine Cruise, which had 150 passengers on board. The train traveled on the long spiral Albula/Bernina route, which has been selected by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. 8. RBI Will Start Its Digital Rupee Pilot Project From Today



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) had announced earlier this month that it would soon start a pilot launch of the digital rupee (E-Rupee) for exclusive use. Now it is going to start from November 1. Actually, now RBI's own digital currency (RBI Digital Currency) is about to become a reality. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) will introduce digital currency for wholesale transactions from November 1. It will start as a pilot project at present. According to the Reserve Bank of India, this will help strengthen India's digital economy, make the payment system more efficient and prevent money laundering. The digital currency will be used for settlement of government securities. 9 banks have

been identified to participate in this project. This will include State Bank of India (SBI), Bank of Baroda (BoB), Union Bank, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank, Kotak Mahindra Bank, IDFC First Bank and HSBC Bank.
