



1. DRDO conducts first successful flight test of interceptor AD - 1 missile



India has achieved great success in developing a weapon to destroy ballistic missiles, fighter ships and enemy aircraft at the highest level of the atmosphere. Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO) conducted the successful flight test of Phase-II Ballistic Missile Defense (BMD) Interceptor AD-1 missile with Large Kill Altitude Bracket from APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha on November 02, 2022. This flight test was conducted with the participation of all the components of the BMD weapon system located at different locations. The AD-1 is a long-range interceptor missile designed to support long-range ballistic missiles as well as low exo-atmospheric aircraft's and Endoatmospheric interception is designed for both. It is powered by a two stage solid motor and indigenously developed advanced control system to accurately guide the missile to the target. Equipped with navigation and guidance algorithms. During this flight-test, all sub-systems performed as expected and were verified by a number of range sensors including radar, telemetry and electrooptical tracking stations deployed to capture flight data. Defense Minister Rajnath Singh congratulated DRDO and other teams involved in the successful flight test of AD-1. He termed it as a unique interceptor with advanced technologies available with very few countries of the world. He expressed confidence that this would further strengthen the BMD capacity of the country. Dr. Sameer V. Kamat, Secretary, Department of Defense Research and Development and Chairman, DRDO, while congratulating his team on this successful test, said that the interceptor will provide the users with

enhanced operational flexibility and can target multiple types of targets. has the capacity.

5. World 's Largest Manuscript Library to be Built in Gujarat



The work of compilation and preservation of ancient manuscripts related to subjects like humanities, grammar, science, religion, culture, spirituality etc. is being done at Shrutirtha Oriental Vidyapeeth of Shankheshwar in Gujarat, which is estimated to cost more than one hundred crore rupees. Giving this information, Tapagachhiya Jain Munishri Hemshraman Vijay Ganivarya, who is doing Chaturmas here for conservation, said that more than 25000 manuscripts are available in the Vidyapeeth and till now more than 10 thousand manuscripts have been preserved and amended. More than one lakh books in the fields of humanities, science, religion, spirituality etc. in the manuscript library. Manuscripts are being modified and preserved, in which work is going on to preserve the manuscripts by rewriting them with pen using hand made ink on the longevity Sanganer paper of Jaipur prepared in ancient style and the copper plate of Odisha. The texts that are being rewritten include the work of Sanskrit, Prakrit, grammar, poetry, justice, scripture, education etc.

That it will be the largest manuscript library in the world. From this work the preservation of manuscripts as well as Devavani Sanskrit, Indian culture and history will be protected and these manuscripts can be preserved as a priceless heritage for the generations to come. This library being built in Gujarat will be the world's largest manuscript institute. Jain Munishree is getting information about the manuscripts available in government and non-government institutions here to bring the ancient heritage in one place and to discover them. He has traveled 25 thousand kilometers for the preservation of manuscripts in 25 years. Recently he completed 1000 km journey from Shankheshwar to Delhi in 36 days and now from 8th November he will travel on foot to Gujarat, Rajasthan, Maharashtra. Available in that library

6. For the first time in the country, CRPF appointed a woman officer on the post of IG



For the first time in the history of the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), two women officers have been promoted to the rank of Inspector General. IG Seema Dhundia will head the Bihar sector of the CRPF, while IG Anne Abraham will head the Rapid Action Force (RAF). According to a senior officer, the CRPF has a history of empowering its women warriors, having achieved the distinction of raising an all-women battalion for the first time in the country in 1986. Both joined the force in 1987 Incidentally Seema Dhundia and Annie Abraham were among the first batch of women officers to join the force in 1987. Both had a stellar career with challenging roles, was marked with achievements and accolades. Dhundia served in sensitive areas IG Seema Dhundia has rendered her services to the nation in highly sensitive areas across the country and was actively involved in

#### 8. Election Commission Announces Election Schedule for Gujarat Assembly Elections
