

1. ' Group of Friends ' formed for UN peacekeepers under the leadership of India



External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Thursday attended the Trusteeship Council meeting after chairing the 'United Nations Security Council Position Meeting: Global Against Terrorism: Challenges and the Way Forward'. with India, Bangladesh, Egypt, France, Contributing countries such as Morocco and Nepal participated as cochairs. S Jaishankar raised concerns about how the involvement of armed groups and terrorists has adversely affected peacekeeping operations ever-increasing amid the globally, challenges to UN peacekeeping missions. Launched a Friends group to promote accountability. At the launch of the Friends group, External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar said that UN peacekeeping is more challenging than ever. It is carried out in ambiguous situations and in hostile areas. Peacekeeping operations have been adversely affected by the

involvement of armed groups, terrorists and transnational organized crime. He said that armed groups, The involvement of terrorists and transnational organized crime adversely affected the has operations of peacekeepers. The External Affairs Minister also noted the recent increase in crimes against External **Affairs** peacekeepers.The Minister further said that statistics show that in the last three years, peacekeepers from 20 countries laid down their lives for the cause of peace. So far 177 Indian peacekeepers have sacrificed their lives. Jaishankar said that preventing crimes against peacekeepers is a multi-stakeholder task of the United Nations. He said it is also a fact that when crimes are committed against peacekeepers, host countries do not have the political will or necessary capacity to ensure such accountability. He said India has facilitated the launch of a database, which will record all crimes against UN peacekeepers. It will also be ready for launch soon. He said that India contributes the largest number of globally. peacekeepers It is worth mentioning that during India's presidency of the UN Security Council in resolution August 2021. a was adopted unanimously on ensuring accountability for crimes against UN peacekeepers.

2. Joe Root became the third player in the world to score 50 wickets and 10,000 runs in Test career



In the Test match being played in Multan between Pakistan and England, Joe Root achieved a unique personal achievement. As soon as he dismissed Faheem Ashraf in Pakistan's second innings, his name joined the special club. Joe Root is the third cricketer in the world to have scored more than 10,000 runs and 50 or more wickets in a Test match. Joe Root came to bowl the 70th over of Pakistan's second innings. In front of him on the fifth ball of the over was Faheem Ashraf, the all-rounder of the host team. In the meantime, he tried to play a ball from Root. The ball went to Jack Crowley after being touched by the bat. Crowley took the catch without making a mistake. This was Root's 50th wicket in Test cricket. He is the third player in the world to score more than 10,000 runs and take 50 wickets in Test cricket. Root has scored 10629 runs in 126 Tests. The charisma of taking more than 10,000 runs and more than 50 wickets in Test cricket has been done by

Jacques Kallis of South Africa and Steve Waugh of Australia in the past. Former South African batsman Kallis scored 13289 runs in Test cricket and also took 292 wickets. He is on top of this list. At the same time, former Australian captain Steve Waugh also took 92 wickets in addition to scoring 10927 runs in Test cricket.

4. India to be first country to auction satcom spectrum



India will be the first country to auction spectrum for satellite communication. Giving this information on Tuesday, Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) Chairman PD Vaghela said that it should be 'designed' with a view to attract investment in the sector. Vaghela said at the Broadband India Forum conference on SATCOM that TRAI It will soon recommend easing of approvals required for satellite communications from various ministries - information and broadcasting, space telecommunications - for ease of doing business in the sector. He said that TRAI

has received a reference from DoT regarding spectrum required for auction and related aspects of satellite based communication. Vaghela said, "I think India will be the first country to auction space-based spectrum. We are working on it. The country will be the first to auction space-based spectrum. 5. India's longest escape tunnel built on the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla rail link project



Another important milestone achieved on Monday in the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla rail link project. Both the ends of Tunnel No. 13, being built to connect Dugga and Savlakot railway stations in the district, were merged. It is the second largest tunnel of the project. The remaining five meter portion at the end was blasted open by SP Mahi, Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of Northern Railway. This explosion was done from a distance of about five hundred meters in the middle of the tunnel. 7. AIIMS, New Delhi declared 'Tobacco Free Zone'



The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in the national capital has been declared a tobacco-free zone and its violation will be considered a punishable offense with a fine of Rs 200. The hospital has said that action will be taken against doctors, permanent or contractual staff and security staff found smoking or chewing tobacco in the premises. The Regulation of Trade and Commerce and Production, Supply and Distribution) Act (COTPA) has been enacted to protect youth and public from the harmful effects of tobacco use and smoking. The official notification

states that in the interest of public health and with a view to keep the buildings hospital clean, contributing to the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the campus of AIIMS, New Delhi has been declared a tobacco-free zone. The order further stated that tobacco. smoking and spitting prohibited in the premises of AIIMS, Delhi and is an offense punishable with a fine of Rs 200. The hospital has requested all the HODs to inform the staff working under them to strictly follow the above guidelines. The security personnel have also been instructed not to allow the use of tobacco in any form patients, attendants and members in the premises of AIIMS. Uma Kumar, head of the rheumatology department of AIIMS, told that we welcome this step. Tobacco harms in many ways. 8. Agni - 5 ballistic missile successfully test - fired from Abdul Kalam Island



India has successfully tested its most dangerous missile Agni-5 on Thursday (December 15) amid ongoing tension on the India-China border. Defense sources said that India today successfully conducted night trial of Agni-5 nuclearcapable Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM), which can hit targets more than 5,000 km away. There was a recent clash between Indian and Chinese soldiers in Tawang, Arunachal Pradesh. Tested from Abdul Kalam Island in Odisha. A dummy war-head was used in the test. This test was done with new techniques and equipment. This missile is lighter than before. Along with this, it has also been informed that this test has proved the ability to increase the range of Agni-5 missile if needed. After India's successful

test of this missile, China must have been in a panic. Agni-5 has been developed by the indigenous defense giant Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO). It was tested by the Strategic Forces Command of the Indian Army from Abdul Kalam Island off the Odisha coast. According to sources, before the test, the authorities issued a notification and the Bay of Bengal was declared a nofly zone. India has been planning to testfire the Agni-5 for a long time, as it would be the fifth missile in a series of intermediate and long-range nuclearcapable ballistic missiles developed from India.
