1. Indian Startup ' Kheti ' Wins The Earthshot Award 2022 _



Indian startup Kheti, a pioneering solution for local smallholder farmers to reduce costs, increase yields and protect livelihoods on the front lines of climate change, is one of five winners of The Earthshot Awards. Prince William and The EarthShot Prize revealed the 2022 winners in Boston on Friday — an accomplished group of entrepreneurs and innovators pioneering unprecedented solutions to repair and regenerate the planet. Each winner will receive a second annual EarthShot prize. The prize, worth £1 million, was awarded at the awards ceremony, which will be broadcast on the BBC on Sunday and begin streaming on pbs.org and the PBS app on December 5. Late US President John F. The Earthshot Prize aims to discover and help innovate innovative solutions that keep the world strong. 3. Prime Minister will dedicate three National Institutes of AYUSH to the country



Prime Minister Narendra Modi will dedicate three National Institutes of AYUSH to the nation on 11 December. These include the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) in Goa, the National Institute of Unani Medicine (NIUM) in Ghaziabad and the National Institute of Homeopathy (NIH) in the capital Delhi. Union AYUSH Minister Sarbananda Sonowal gave this information on Tuesday. He said that the institute research Will further strengthen international collaboration with Ayurveda and facilitate affordable AYUSH services to a large population. In a press conference held here, the Union Minister also gave details of the 9th World Ayurveda Congress (WAC), to be held in Panjim, Goa from 8-11 December. He said that it would highlight the scientificity, efficacy and potential inherent in the AYUSH system. Speaking on the occasion, Sonowal said, "The establishment of these institutes is in line with the Prime Minister's vision to expand infrastructure and human resources and promote research in traditional systems of medicine. Through these institutions, the Government of India will further strengthen its capabilities to provide affordable and better health facilities to every citizen and region of

the country. He said that with the establishment of these three National Institutes of AYUSH. 400 additional seats will be created for the undergraduate-masters (UG-PG) and doctorate students in Avurveda, Homeopathy and Unani. Will work to provide the highest quality facilities for UG-PG and Post Doctoral courses in aspects of research and patient care services.

4. Cyclonic storm 'Mandaus' is going to hit the Bay of Bengal




A cyclonic storm rising in the Bay of Bengal is about to change the weather of Chhattisgarh. Due to its effect, clouds will cover the Bastar and Durg divisions of the state from December 8. By the next day, they can be expanded in the entire state. There is a possibility that there may be light to moderate rain on December 10. According to the Meteorological Department, the cyclonic storm Mandaus in the Bay of Bengal is going to reach Tamil Nadu on December 8. It will affect Puducherry and Tata in Andhra Pradesh. Due to this, heavy rain alert has been issued in the coastal areas of Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Andhra Pradesh. This will also affect the weather of Chhattisgarh. Scientist of Raipur Meteorological Center H.P. Chandra said, due to the effect of this storm, clouds will start coming in the southern part of Chhattisgarh on December 8. It is located in the areas of central and north Chhattisgarh i.e.

Durg, Raipur, It will also reach Bilaspur and Surguja divisions. There is a possibility of rain in the state on December 10. There may be good rains in South Chhattisgarh. Whereas in the areas of Surguja division, it can be limited to drizzle. According to meteorologists, the arrival of dry and cold winds from the north and the arrival of moist air from the south in the winter season increases the possibility of rain. 6. World's first gold ATM established in Hyderabad



Till now money is withdrawn from ATMs, but such an ATM has been started in Hyderabad, the capital of Telangana, from which gold coins

can be withdrawn. People will be able to buy gold coins through debit or credit card through this ATM installed by Goldsikka, a gold trading company. This is not only India, but the world's first real-time gold ATM. This ATM has been launched with the technical support of Hyderabad based startup company Opencube Technologies. With this, people can buy coins of 0.5, 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 and 100 grams as per their requirement. According to Pratap, Vice President, GoldSikka, after launching the first gold ATM, the company will soon install three to four more such ATMs in different areas of Hyderabad. At present the focus of the company is on South India. Later nationwide 3, There is a plan to install 000 gold ATMs. The company aims to launch this service in other countries as well. Significantly, although there is a huge demand for gold in the whole country, but the demand for gold is more in the states of southern India. The Gold ATM has the capacity to hold five kg of gold. One specialty of the ATM is that the price of gold will be updated live in it. The coins kept in it will be 24 carat and 999 certified. The ATM will be operational for 24 hours. 7. Maharashtra is the first state to set up a disability department



The Maharashtra government has announced the creation of a new department for differently-abled people. Addressing a program in Mumbai on Saturday on the occasion of International Handicapped Day, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde said that a separate disabled department would be set up in the state for the welfare of the disabled. He said that an amount of Rs 1,143 crore would be allocated for this. CM Shinde said that Maharashtra is the first state in the country to set up the Department of Disabilities. He said his government has created 2,063 posts for the new department which will frame policies for the welfare of the disabled taking into consideration the views of all stakeholders. The formation of the Department of Disabilities was approved in the state cabinet meeting. The government says that under the Department of Social Justice and Special Assistance, a new Disabled Welfare Department will be formed for disabled people. Currently, the social justice department is responsible for welfare activities for the differently-abled, which oversees education, training and rehabilitation for them.

8. RBI increased repo rate by 0.35% to 6.25%



The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on Wednesday increased the policy rate repo by 0.35 per cent to 6.25 per cent in the bi-monthly monetary policy review, mainly for the purpose of controlling inflation. Along with this, the central bank has reduced the GDP growth forecast for the current financial year 2022-23 from seven percent to 6.8 percent. Repo rate is the interest rate at which commercial banks can meet their immediate needs. To meet this, they take a loan from the central bank. An increase in this means that borrowing from banks and financial institutions will be costlier and the monthly installment (EMI) of the existing loan will increase. Giving information about the decision taken in the three-day meeting of the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC), which began on Monday, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said in a televised statement, "Considering the current economic situation, the MPC has decided to keep the policy rate repo 0.35". Increase the percentage by 6. It has been decided to do 25 percent. With this increase in the repo rate, the Standing Deposit Facility (SDF) rate has been adjusted to 6 per cent and the Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate to 6.50 per cent. However, this pace of increase in the reportate is lower than the previous four increases and the market was expecting it. RBI has increased the repo rate by 2.25 per cent five times since

May this year mainly to control inflation. Earlier, the repo rate was increased by 0.40 per cent in May and 0.50-0.50 per cent in June, August and September. The central bank mainly takes into account retail inflation while deciding on the policy rate and it has remained above the Reserve Bank's satisfactory level for the last 11 months. Inflation based on the Consumer Price Index stood at 6.7 per cent in October. This pace of increase in the reportate is lower than the previous four increases and the market was expecting it.
