

## 1. RBI to start trading with Russia and Sri Lanka in Indian rupee for the first time



Now other countries are also taking interest in the mechanism of settlement of international trade in Indian Rupee. Tajikistan, Cuba, Luxembourg and Sudan have started talking to India to use the mechanism. This is being claimed in media reports by quoting official documents. Russia has already started using this mechanism following sanctions on Moscow following its war with Ukraine. The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in July set up a mechanism to settle international trade in rupees instead of dollars. A government official and a source familiar with the development have said that the government is trying to bring into the system those countries which are short of dollars. Based on the documents, four countries have shown interest in opening special rupee accounts, called Vostro accounts. Although, Participating banks in India have not yet provided these facilities. Opening of these accounts requires approval from the Reserve Bank of India. Documents reveal that Mauritius and Sri Lanka have also shown interest in settling international trade in Indian rupee and have their special Vostro accounts approved by the RBI. have seen. According to the document, India's central bank has approved banks to open 12 vostro accounts for trading in rupees with Russia. Six other accounts have been authorized, including five for trade with Sri Lanka and one for trade with Mauritius, according to the documents. Federal Ministry of Finance,

#### 2. New transgender law passed by Spain



According to the draft of this new law being brought by the Spanish government, citizens above the age of 14 will be allowed to change their name and gender. To do this, they will not have to give any evidence or bring any witnesses. Right now the concerned person has to submit some health related reports. In addition, minors also have to provide proof of consent from their medical and legal guardians. After the new law is implemented, the need for all these will end. The government has said that this step has been taken to enhance the rights of transgender citizens and to make their lives easier. Government spokeswoman Maria Jesus Montero said, "With this law we want to change some of the situations that existed historically." These include the historically invisible position of LGBTQ (lesbian-bisexual-transgender-queer) communities in society, The practice of stigmatizing them and not acknowledging their rights are included. The draft that the government has presented will now be tabled in Parliament. It cannot be said with certainty that it will be approved in the Parliament of Spain. ## 6. Sitwini Rabuka will be the new Prime Minister of Fiji



Sitwini Rabuka has been elected as the new Prime Minister of Fiji. Fiji is preparing to welcome its new Prime Minister after 16 years. The way for Rabuka's appointment was cleared after the election of a hung parliament. Rabuka is the leader of the People's Alliance, a political party in Fiji formed in 2021. Fiji's Social Democratic Liberal Party (SODELPA) voted on Friday to form a coalition with Rabuka's People's Alliance and the National Federation Party. In the secret parliamentary vote for prime minister, Rabuka received 28 votes, while 27 members of parliament voted for Fiji leader Vorake Bainimarama. Rabuka had twice staged a coup as head of the army in 1987 and became prime minister in 1992 before being ousted in elections in 1999. It is the first time in 16 years that three parties have come together to form a coalition government. The Pacific island country of 9 lakh people has a history of military coups before the constitutional reform in 2013.Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated Fiji's newly elected Prime Minister Rabuka. PM Modi tweeted that I look forward to working together to further strengthen the close and long-standing ties between India and Fiji.


## 7. Mickey Hothi becomes the first Sikh mayor of the city of Lodi, California



Mickey Hothy has been unanimously elected as the 117th mayor of the city of Lodi, Northern California. He

has become the first Sikh to hold this post. Hothi, the son of Punjabi parents, previously served as Deputy Mayor under Mayor Mark Chandler. Hothi will serve a two-year term as the city's mayor. He will preside over Common Council meetings and serve as the city's executive officer. "Honoured to be sworn in as the 117th mayor of the City of Lodi," Hothy tweeted after being sworn in this month. The Lodi Times quoted Hothy as saying that everyone came to Lodi because they realized it was a safe family town. Great education, great people, great culture, great values and just hard working people in this city. I am proud to represent this community. Growing up in the city was a challenge, said Hothi, a 2008 graduate of Tokay High School. Especially after 9/11, when many Muslims and Sikhs experienced undue persecution. The Lodi Times reported that his family was also instrumental in the establishment of the Sikh Temple on Armstrong Road. He was first elected to the Lodi City Council from District 5 in November of 2020. Lodi is a city located in San Joaquin County, California with an estimated population of 67,021 as of the 2021 census data.

## 8. Atal Memorial to be built in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh



A memorial for former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee will be built in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh. The state government has allotted land for this. The city of Gwalior is the birthplace of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee. There was a demand for building his memorial here, now the government has given approval for it. Gwalior's Divisional Commissioner Deepak Singh said that as per the proposal, the Collector has allocated about 4,000 crores for the construction of the memorial of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee in Sirol area. 050 hectares of land has been allotted. The official said that the proposal for allotment of land was approved by the Divisional Level Nazul Committee with

the consent of Municipal Corporation and Town and Country Planning Department. Last year on August 16, on Vajpayee's death anniversary, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had announced the construction of a grand memorial for the former prime minister in Gwalior. Let us tell you that former PM Vajpayee was born on December 25, 1924 in Gwalior. He led the BJP at the center in the late 1990s and early 2000s and remained the Prime Minister of India for six years. His B.A. Till then studied at Victoria College, Gwalior.
