



1. Khelo India Youth Games to see 6,000 athletes in 27 sports



On 30 January 2023, Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan inaugurated the fifth edition of Khelo India Youth Games in a grand ceremony. The Chief Minister declared the Games inaugurated at the Tatya Tope Stadium in state capital Bhopal. Union Sports and Youth Affairs Minister Anurag Singh Thakur and Madhya Pradesh Sports Minister Yashodhara Raje Scindia were present on the occasion. Actually, Khelo India Youth Games has started in Madhya Pradesh from January 30. Starting from January 30 till February 11, a total of 27 games will be held in this tournament which will run in different cities of the state. During this program Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh, Sports Minister Anurag Thakur, Minister of State for Sports Nishith Pramanik and Madhya Pradesh Sports Minister Yashodhara Raje Scindia were present. During this, Chouhan said, "Khelo India Youth Games in Madhya Pradesh will be historic." Speaking at the opening ceremony, Chauhan congratulated the India Under-19 women's team for winning the T20 World Cup in South Africa on Sunday. The 13-day sporting players for extravaganza will prepare future like international competitions the Asiad, Commonwealth and Olympic Games. 3. Former law minister and senior lawyer Shanti Bhushan passed away



Former Law Minister and senior advocate Shanti Bhushan passed away. He was 97 years old. It was Shanti Bhushan who represented Rajnarayan in a very famous case in the Allahabad High Court. In 1974, Indira Gandhi was ordered to step down from the post of Prime Minister. He served as the Law Minister of India from 1977 to 1979 in the Morarji Desai ministry. Shanti Bhushan's sons Jayant and Prashant Bhushan are also well-known lawyers. Shanti Bhushan was active in the legal profession until recently and argued the PIL filed in the apex court, In which a request was made to conduct an investigation under the supervision of the court in the Rafale fighter jet deal case. Former Law Minister Shanti Bhushan had filed a PIL in the Supreme Court in 2018 demanding a change in the 'master of roster' system. It was pleaded in the petition that the principle and procedure for sending cases to a bench under the roster should be decided. Shanti Bhushan had filed this petition through his son and lawyer Prashant Bhushan. Shanti Bhushan was an active member of the Congress (O) party and later of the Janata Party. He was also a member of the Rajya Sabha from 14 July 1977 to 2 April 1980. In 1980, he joined the Bharatiya Janata Party. In 1986, when the Bharatiya Janata Party did not accept his advice on an election petition, he resigned from the party. According to information, The Economic Survey was presented in both the houses on the first day of the budget session. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman will present the Union Budget in Parliament today. The first part of Bastra will continue till February 10. After this, the second part of the budget session will start on March 6 and will continue till April 6.

7. Gautam Adani out of the list of world's top-10 billionaires



Gautam Adani was expected to become the world's biggest rich man and now he is out of the top-10 list. There has been a major reshuffle in the list of Top-10 Billionaires of the world. Both Indian industrialists Gautam Adani and Mukesh Ambani, involved in this for a long time, are now out of the list. On January 24, 2023, after the Hindenburg Report, published by the American research firm Hindenburg regarding the Adani Group, there was a sharp fall in the shares of companies led by Gautam Adani, and this affected their net worth in such a way that Within a week, he was out of the list of the rich. Gautam Adani's net worth has seen the biggest decline ever since the Hindenburg report came out. It has been just a week since this report was published and according to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index, Gautam Adani's total assets have come down to just 84. 4 billion dollars left. With this much net worth, Adani is now the 11th richest person in the world. Adani has now come at number 11 in the Bloomberg Billionaire Index, leaving behind even Carlos Slim. Ambani is behind him at the 12th position. His assets are \$ 82.2 billion. Sergey Brin is in 9th place. His assets are \$ 86.4 billion. Last year, only Mukesh Ambani and Gautam Adani's wealth increased in the list of world's top-10 rich. Adani was also number one in earning that year. This year, Mukesh Ambani has moved out of the top-10 billionaires of the Bloomberg Billionaires Index to the 12th position. Gautam Adani, chairman of the Adani Group, has topped the list of world's billionaires in terms of wealth loss this year, who has lost \$36.1 billion so far. He is followed by Mukesh Ambani, chairman of Reliance Group. Ambani has lost \$4.96

billion so far this year. At number three is Radhakrishna Damani of DMart. He 2.

# 8. Visakhapatnam will be the new capital of Andhra Pradesh: CM Jagan Reddy



There has been a change in the capital of Andhra Pradesh. Now Visakhapatnam will be known as the new capital of this South Indian state. Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy has announced this. Along with this, he has also announced the organization of Global Investor Summit in the new capital. According to the video posted by CM Reddy's official Twitter handle, he said, 'I invite you to Visakhapatnam, which is going to become our capital in the coming days. I am also shifting to Visakhapatnam in coming few months. We are going to organize this summit in Visakhapatnam on 3rd and 4th March. The special thing is that the Andhra Pradesh government has taken this decision after 9 years of separation from Telangana. Amaravati was declared the capital of Andhra Pradesh on 23 April 2015. After this, in the year 2020, three capitals of the state were planned. Among these Amravati, The names of Visakhapatnam and Kurnool are included. However, it was later withdrawn and Amaravati remained the capital. Andhra Pradesh's ruling party YSR Congress has accused Telugu Desam Party leader N Chandrababu Naidu of former chief minister of the state in an alleged land scam. Amravati was the center in this matter also. Reddy's party had also demanded a CBI inquiry into the matter. However, Naidu continued to deny it.
