



# 1. Smriti Mandhana became the costliest player of WPL



Indian batsman Smriti Mandhana became the most expensive player in the first Women's Premier League auction in Mumbai. Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) bought Mandhana for Rs 3.4 crore. Mandhana has now become twice the highest earning player in Pakistan Super League (PSL). In the auction, 10 Indian players were successful in getting more than one crore rupees, but captain Harmanpreet Kaur was included in their team by Mumbai Indians for a much cheaper Mandhana in half the amount for Rs 1.80 crore. He is not even Mumbai's costliest player as the team bought England's Nat Sciver Brunt for the highest amount of Rs 3.20 crore. In fact, Harmanpreet is not even among the top six Indian players bought at the auction as the country's second highest selling player is all-rounder Deepti Sharma, who was bought by UP Warriors for Rs.

2. Country's first AC electric double decker bus will run in Mumbai



The first AC double decker electric bus has also started in India. It was inaugurated by Union Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari in Mumbai. Actually, many double decker buses have been operating in Mumbai before, but India's first AC double decker electric bus (India's 1st AC Double Decker Bus) has been inaugurated. This bus was inaugurated by Union Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari. This bus has been started keeping in mind the goal of zero carbon emission in the country. The electric

double decker bus is equipped with live tracking device, CCTV cameras and a panic button for women safety. These buses will be 100 percent digital with tap-in and tap-out facility. Whereas during the time when a bus has a maximum seating capacity of 65 passengers, The double decker AC bus will carry 90 passengers. This electric double decker bus will reduce air pollution. The route of these buses will be South Mumbai, BKC Kurla and Andheri and it is believed that there will be less rush of passengers with normal fares.

3. Russian arms supply to India \$13 billion in last 5 years



Russia's official news agencies reported that India has received weapons worth about \$ 13 billion from Russia in the last five years. In addition, New Delhi has placed orders worth more than \$10 billion for arms and military equipment with Moscow. India accounts for about 20 per cent of Moscow's current order book and is the world's largest buyer of Russian arms. While New Delhi has not openly condemned Russia's invasion of Ukraine, Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi has called for dialogue and diplomacy to resolve the conflict. Dmitry Shugayev, head of Russia's Federal Service for Military-Technical Cooperation, agencies that India, China and some Southeast Asian countries have continued to show interest in buying Russian weapons. The agency reported that annual arms exports have been around \$14-15 billion, While the order book is stable at around \$50 billion. Shugayev said Russia's S-400 Triumf missile defense system, shortrange surface-to-air missile systems such as the Osa, Pechora or Strela, as well as Sukhoi Su-30 fighter jets, MiG-29 helicopters and drones will be used in Asia. countries of particular interest.

4. "Former German Chancellor Angela Merkel UNESCO" awarded Peace Prize



Former German Chancellor Angela Merkel has been awarded the 2022 UNESCO Peace Prize for her efforts to welcome refugees. Jury President and 2018 Nobel Peace Prize winner Denis Mukwege said all jury members were impressed by their courageous decision to welcome more than 1.2 million refugees from Syria, Iraq, Afghanistan and Eritrea in 2015. This is the legacy he has left. Additionally, the jury awarded an honorable mention to Julien Lusanz for her commitment to victims of sexual violence. She is best known for her work in North Kivu in the Democratic Republic of Congo, where he condemned rape as a "weapon of war". The honor is named after a former President of Ivory Coast. Officially called the Felix Houphouet-Boigny-UNESCO Peace Prize. It has been awarded each year since 1989 to individuals, organizations or institutions who have made special efforts to promote, research or secure peace. It has not yet been decided when the award will be presented to Merkel, who quit politics last year after serving four terms as chancellor. Angela Merkel (full name- Angela Dorothea Kasner) was born on 17 July 1954 in Hamburg, West Germany. He is trained as a physicist and entered politics after the fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989. In the 2005 national elections, Merkel became the first female Chancellor of Germany.

5. Hyundai Motors India appoints two more women cricketers as ambassadors



**Hyundai Motor India Limited** has signed two more women cricketers to its roster of brand ambassadors,

Yastika Bhatia and Renuka Singh Thakur. Bhatia and Thakur will be joined by Smriti Mandhana, Shefali Verma and Jemimah Rodrigues. 6. Jean-Eric Vergne wins Formula E-Prix Hyderabad, India



Experienced driver Jean-Eric Vergne of DS Penske won the Hyderabad E-Prix. The Formula E race marked the successful return of top-level motorsport competition to India. The 33-lap electrifying race saw Vergne put up a tough challenge from Envision Racing's Nick Cassidy but managed to hold him off in the end. When Vergne approached the finishing line, his car had only 0.5% energy left. The winner's trophy was presented by the Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports, Anurag Thakur. Nick Cassidy (Envision Racing) and Antonio Félix da Costa (TAG Heuer Porsche Formula E Team) finished second and third respectively. He benefited from a 17second penalty on Sébastien Biemi. Mahindra Racing, competing in their first home race, got a point from Olivier Rolland. He finished in tenth place. It was Vergne's 11th win in Formula E but his first in two years and the double champion needed an energy-saving defensive tackle to hold off New Zealand's Cassidy at Lake Hussain Sagar.

7. Nicos Christodoulides becomes the new President of Cyprus



Former Foreign Minister Nikos Christodoulides was elected President of Cyprus on 13 February after a second and final round of voting. Christodoulides, 49, won 51.9% of the vote, while his opponent Andreas Mavroyanis, 66, took 48.1%. Significantly, this time in Cyprus, 72.4% i.e. more than 4,05,000 people voted. It is higher than before. He was appointed Government Spokesperson in 2014 and Foreign Minister in 2018. Christodoulides is supported by the Democratic Party, the Movement for Social Democracy and the Democratic Alignment. Cyprus was divided in 1974, when Turkish forces occupied the northern part in response to a Greek-sponsored coup d'état. Since then the current issue between Cyprus and Turkey is the ongoing dispute between the Greek Cypriots in the south and the Turkish Cypriots in the north.

8. First woman astronaut to go on space mission from Saudi Arabia in 2023



By the end of this year, Saudi Arabia will send its first female astronaut to space. Rayana Barnawi will go on a mission to the International Space Center (ISS) along with her fellow astronaut Ali Al-Karni, the official Saudi Press Agency said. The agency said that both the astronauts will go to space along with the crew of Mission AX-2. This mission will be launched from USA. The crew will be launched to the ISS on a SpaceX Falcon 9 rocket from NASA's Kennedy Space Center in Florida. Saudi Arabia is also following in the footsteps of UAE. In the year 2019, UAE became the first Arab country to

register its name in history by sending one of its citizens into space. Even before this, Saudi Arabia has gone into space. In 1985, Royal Prince Sultan bin Salman became the first Muslim Arab astronaut to be part of a US-run space mission.
