

1. K. Krithivasan appointed CEO of Tata Consultancy Services (TCS)



Rajesh Gopinathan, Managing Director and CEO of Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) has decided to resign from his position and pursue other interests. Gopinathan has been associated with the company for over two decades. The board of directors of TCS has approved his request and appointed K Krithivasan as CEO in-charge with effect from March 16, 2023. Rajesh Gopinathan will remain with TCS till September 15, 2023, to help in the transition to his successor. During his six-year tenure, TCS managed to build giant conglomerates, adding over \$10 billion in revenue and growing its market capitalization to over \$70 billion. TCS, which has been in operation for over 55 years, has had only four CEOs in its history and K Krithivasan will become the fifth CEO. The company is known for having an extremely stable management team, which is unusual in the industry.

2. National Company Law Tribunal approves merger of HDFC Limited with HDFC Bank



The National Company Law Tribunal approved the merger of HDFC Limited with HDFC Bank. Under the terms of the merger, each shareholder of HDFC will get 42 shares of HDFC Bank for every 25 shares of HDFC Bank. When the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approved the merger of HDFC Limited with HDFC Bank, the decks were cleared for the creation of a financial

giant. The amalgamation has already received approval from the Competition Commission of India, Reserve Bank of India, stock exchanges, shareholders and insurance and pension regulators. HDFC and HDFC Bank had announced the merger in April last year and said the process would be completed by the second quarter or third quarter of the next financial year. Under the terms of the merger, each shareholder of HDFC will get 42 shares of HDFC Bank for every 25 shares of HDFC Bank. The companies also said that post merger, HDFC Bank will be 100 per cent owned by public shareholders and existing shareholders of HDFC will hold 41 per cent of the lender. While the announcement came after market hours, HDFC Bank stock ended at Rs 1,572.55 on the BSE - a gain of 1.36 per cent or Rs 21.10 over its previous close while HDFC counter rose 1.14 per cent or Rs 28.80 to close at Rs 2,561.45. 3. Indian Railways to become Net Zero Carbon Emitter by 2030



Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav recently said in a written reply to a question in the Lok Sabha that the

Indian Railways is working on a mission mode to become the largest green railway in the world and towards becoming a "net zero carbon emitter" by 2030. is increasing. Indian Railways has taken several initiatives to reduce carbon emissions which include the use of energy efficient technologies. Indian Railways is starting production of three phase electric locomotives with regenerative features, use of Head on Generation (HOG) technology, use of LED lights in buildings and coaches, use of star rated equipment. In addition, key strategies identified to achieve the net zero carbon emission target are procurement of electricity through renewable energy sources, shift from diesel to electric traction, promotion of energy efficiency, afforestation. The estimated energy demand of Indian Railways is expected to be around 8,200 Mega Watts (MW) in 2029-30. To achieve net zero carbon emissions, the expected requirement of renewable capacity by 2029-30 would be around 30,000 MW. By February 2023, about 147 MW of solar plants and about 103 MW of wind power plants have been commissioned. In addition, about 2150 MW of renewable capacity has also been tied up. Indian Railways plans to progressively procure renewable energy through various power purchase modes for its future energy requirements. 7. Gaganyaan's first abort mission will be in May: Government



The purpose of the Gaganyaan program is to demonstrate India's capability to launch humans into the low polar region using an Indian launch vehicle and be able to bring them back safely. The program consists of four abort missions, with the first mission scheduled for May 2023. The program also includes several test vehicle missions and an unmanned mission for 2024. The total expenditure till 30 October 2022 was Rs 3,040 crore. Human-rated launch vehicle systems have been tested and platform operating system tests have also been completed. They have designed the crew escape system and the platform is ready for the first flight. The crew module structure has been delivered for the TV-D1 mission and static testing of all crew escape system motors has been completed. Batch testing is currently underway. The Gaganyaan program is India's advanced human space travel programme. It aims to showcase India's capability to launch humans into the lower Earth's mantle and bring them back safely. The program envisages a crewed vehicle being designed, developed and launched into space using an Indian launch vehicle.

8. Deepak Mohanty appointed as PFRDA chairman and Mamta Shankar as whole time member



The Indian government has appointed Deepak Mohanty as the new chairman of the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA), replacing Supratim Bandhopadhyay after his term ends in January. Mohanty, former executive director of the

Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and has served as a member of the PFRDA. Also, Mamta Shankar has been appointed as the new Whole-time Member (Economics) for a minimum term of three years or till the age of 62 years or until further orders. The total assets under management under the National Pension System and Atal Pension Yojana stood at Rs 8.81 lakh crore as on March 4, 2023. Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA) was established in 2003 with the objective to encourage, regulate and develop the pension industry in India. Initially, it provided service only to government employees, but later it extended to all Indian citizens and NRIs, extended its services to self-employed persons as well. PFRDA focuses on promoting, developing and regulating organized pension funds such as entrepreneurial pension funds such as the National Pension System (NPS) so that people can get income in the years lived in an unfortunate manner.
