



#### 1. Luis Caffarelli wins 2023 Abel Prize



Lewis Caffarelli has been awarded the 2023 Abel Prize. He has been given this award for his contribution to the mathematics of nonlinear partial equations and freeboundary problems. This most prestigious award in mathematics is considered equivalent to the Nobel Prize. For the first time this award was given to Jean Pierre in 2003 for modernizing many parts of mathematics. The Abel Prize was started in honor of the famous mathematician Niels Hernick. The Norwegian government instituted the award in 2001 and the first award was given to Jean Pierre in 2003. The winner of the award is given a cash amount of Rs 4 crore 72 lakh along with the medal. Abel is called the Nobel Prize of Mathematics. There are two reasons for this, the first is that the Nobel Prize is not given in mathematics. Second, The Abel Prize is the most prestigious mathematics prize in the world. This award is given every year to one or more people for their contribution to mathematics. This is the reason why it is called the Nobel Prize of Mathematics.


2. Intel co-founder Gordon Moore passes away at the age of 94



Silicon Valley pioneer and Intel co-founder Gordon Moore has died at his home in Hawaii on March 24 at the age of 94. He was instrumental in the design and

manufacturing of semiconductor chips. Gordon Earle Moore was born on January 3, 1929 in San Francisco. He obtained his degree from the University of California at Berkeley. He began his research career at the Johns Hopkins Applied Physics Laboratory in Maryland. He returned to California in 1956 to join Shockley Semiconductor. Moore and Noyce co-founded Intel. He received the National Medal of Technology from President George H.W. Bush.


# 6. Income Tax Department launches mobile app 'AIS' for taxpayers

access Annual Information Statement (AIS) and Taxpayer Information Statement (TIS) through this mobile app. These services will be provided free of cost by the Income Tax Department. Taxpayers will be able to install the mobile app 'AIS for Taxpayers' from Google Play Store and App Store.

8. Tamil Nadu's 18th wildlife sanctuary opens in Erode



The Tamil Nadu government has decided to declare Thanthai Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary as the 18th wildlife sanctuary in the state. The sanctuary covers an area of

80,567 hectares in Anthiyur and Gobichettipalayam taluks of Erode district, and includes reserve forest areas Anthiyur, Bargur, Thattakarai and Chennampatti. It is home to various wild animals like tiger, elephant, leopard, wild boar, gaur and deer. This wildlife sanctuary is located in close proximity to other sanctuaries in Karnataka like Malai Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary, BRT Wildlife Sanctuary, Cauvery Wildlife Sanctuary, and acts as a link between Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve and Cauvery South Wildlife Sanctuary. This announcement was made during the state budget. The newly designated wildlife sanctuary will facilitate the placement of more anti-poaching vigilantes and camps against encroachment. In addition, removal of invasive species, Efforts will be made to reduce man-animal conflict, and promote conservation of the Asian elephant. The forest department official has assured the tribals residing near the sanctuary that they will not face any restrictions while carrying out their work in the area. Officials' spokesperson Rajkumar clarified that the tribal people living in the six habitations of the sanctuary already have rights and will continue to enjoy their rights under the Forest Rights Act.
