

1. NGT slaps Rs 10 crore fine on Kerala government for failing to protect Ramsar sites



The Kollam district administration has constituted special enforcement teams in collaboration with the local self-government to detect waste management violations, a serious issue threatening the ecosystem of the Ashtamudi lake. The squad will take action against violations including poor waste treatment, uncontrolled garbage dumping and storage and sale of banned plastic products. Meanwhile, the flimsy efforts of the local selfgovernance and district administration were exposed when the principal bench of the National Green Tribunal (NGT), New Delhi imposed a fine of Rs 10 crore on the Kerala government for failing to stop indiscriminate pollution at the Ramsar sites of Vembanad and Ashtamudi. Fined Rs. The amount of the fine will have to be deposited in the ring fence account operated under the authority of the Chief Secretary within one month., The NGT order clearly shows that the waste management system in the areas around Ashtamudi and Vembanad lakes is abysmal. Our local governments and district administrations struggled to set up effective waste management systems. Obviously untreated waste from hospitals and homes is dumped directly into the lake. Ramsar sites are inter-residential, due to which more than one contracting party is responsible for the conservation and management of more than one treaty.

2. Mumbai Indians WPL: Harman's captaincy, Haley's all-round game



Mumbai Indians, captained by Harmanpreet Kaur, defeated Delhi Capitals and won the title of the first season of the Women's Premier League (WPL). Mumbai achieved the target of 132 runs with three balls to spare in the final match held at the Brabourne Stadium on 26 March. If seen, in this title journey of Mumbai Indians, the whole team united and performed brilliantly. However, the performance of some players was particularly impressive. Let's know about those five players of Mumbai Indians who performed brilliantly in the entire WPL season. Hayley Mathews was the biggest superstar of Mumbai Indians' victory. West Indies captain Hayley Mathews scored 271 runs in 10 matches at an average of 30.11, including a half-century. English Nat Sciver-Brunt also contributed all-rounder significantly to the title win. Siever-Brunt managed to score 332 runs in 10 matches at an average of 66.40. Zeeland's Emilia Kerr performed brilliantly for her team throughout the season. 22-year-old Emilia Kerr took 15 wickets at an average of just 14.06. This fast bowler from England took a memorable hat-trick in the Eliminator match against UP Warriors. Mumbai Indians captain Harmanpreet Kaur led her team from the front. Harmanpreet Kaur scored 281 runs at an average of 40.41, which included three half-centuries.

3. Government hikes raw jute MSP by Rs 300 to Rs 5,050 per quintal



The central government has decided to increase the prices of jute, giving great relief to the farmers. In fact, the Central Government has approved the MSP of raw jute under the chairmanship of PM Modi, in which the minimum support price (MSP) of raw jute has been increased by Rs 300 to Rs 5050 per quintal for the 2023-24 season. The declared MSP of raw jute for 023-24 season is in line with the principle of fixing the MSP at a level of at least 1.5 times the all-India weighted average cost of production, which was announced by the government in the 2018-19 budget. Apart from this, the increase in the MSP of raw jute will ensure a return of 63.20%, which will benefit about 40 lakh farmers and 4 lakh workers associated with the jute industry. Jute industry has an important place in the national economy of India. Especially in West Bengal where around 75 jute mills are operational and provide livelihood to lakhs of workers. After this decision, 40 lakh farmer families associated with jute sector will get help and they will be financially empowered. The decision will also help the jute sector in Bihar, Odisha, Assam, Tripura, Meghalaya, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

There is no dearth of sports talents in Uttarakhand. Continuous efforts are being made to provide better sports facilities to the youth in the state. In this regard, he said that in the year 2024, National Games will be organized in Uttarakhand.

6. Gift to central employees, 4% increase in dearness allowance



Taking a big decision in the cabinet meeting, the central government has made a big increase in dearness allowance. DA has been increased by 4 percent. The central government has increased the dearness allowance by 4 percent to 42 percent. Union Minister Anurag Thakur gave this information. Union Minister Anurag Thakur said that the government will spend Rs 12815 crore on DA hike. After this increase, the dearness allowance of central employees will increase from 38 percent to 42 percent. A meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs was held under the chairmanship of Prime Minister Narendra Modi today. The DA hike was approved in this meeting. The increased dearness allowance has come into effect from January 1. Along with 47 lakh central employees, 69 lakh pensioners will also get the benefit of this decision of the central government. Along with dearness allowance, the benefit of DR i.e. Dearness Relief will be given to the central pensioners. After this increase to pensioners Will get 42 percent DR instead of 38 percent. The central government implemented it from 1 January 2023. That is, the arrears of January and February will increase with the salary of March.

7. Cabinet approves focused subsidy for beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana



PM Narendra Modi-led cabinet extends LPG cylinder subsidy of Rs 200 for beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana for one year The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has announced that Rs. per LPG cylinder under Rs. 200 subsidy will be extended for one year. PMUVY was launched by the central government in May 2016 to provide collateral-free LPG connections to adult women from poor households and to deliver LPG to rural and poor households. The government credits the subsidy to the bank accounts of the eligible beneficiaries of the users. Total expenditure for the financial year 2022-23 Rs 6,100 crore! and 7,680 crore for 2023-24 would be Rs. Subsidy directly to eligible beneficiaries! Deposited in bank accounts. Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies ie Indian Oil Corporation! Ltd. (IOCL), Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (BPCL) and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Ltd. (HPCL) are already providing this subsidy before May 22, 2022. There has been a sharp increase in the international prices of LPG due to various geo-political reasons. It is important to protect the PMUY beneficiaries from high LPG prices.

8. Government of India Launches DigiClaim Platform for Farmer Insurance Claims



India's Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar has introduced a new platform called 'DigiClaim' on the National Crop Insurance Portal. The objective of this platform is to expedite the payment of insurance claims to the farmers availing crop insurance. The minister made instant insurance claim payments totaling Rs 1260.35 crore to insured farmers in some Indian states such as Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttarakhand and Haryana in a single click using the platform. Indian Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar has launched a new platform called 'DigiClaim' on the National Crop Insurance Portal, which is designed to speed up payment of insurance claims to farmers taking crop insurance schemes. A total of 1260 farmers were insured in some Indian states like Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh.
