

1. India ranked fourth in SIPRI 's Global Military Expenditure Report \_\_\_



India has become the country with the fourth largest defense budget in the world. In 2022, India has spent a total of 23 percent for the armed forces in terms of modernization of equipment and strengthening military infrastructure. Last year, Rs 5.25 lakh crore was allocated for military expenditure in the budget from India, while An amount of Rs 4.78 lakh crore was allocated from 2021 to 2022. Countries have spent \$ 2240 billion i.e. Rs 183 lakh crore on their armies. India is at number four in this list. In this, Saudi Arabia is at number five, which spent \$ 75 billion last year, while Russia is at number three, this country has spent \$ 86.4 billion, while China is at number two and America at first. China has spent \$292 billion while \$877 billion.

2. PM Modi inaugurates India's first water metro in Kochi



Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first phase of the Kochi Water Metro. The Water Metro, which is India's first of its kind public boat service integrated with the Metro Rail network, will integrate Kochi's water transport system. The Water Metro service will provide electrically powered hybrid ferries

that will connect the mainland to the islands in Kochi, thereby Over one lakh residents will be benefitted. The project includes boats that are air-conditioned, battery operated, hybrid and disabled-friendly with other features. The water metro will travel through water bodies similar to any other conventional boat or ferry service, but will have modern facilities, better safety and security measures.

4. Solar industry to supply indigenous UAV 'Nagastra-1' to Indian Army



that it has bagged the contract to supply Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) Nagastra to the Indian Army that in line with the government's initiative to bring in self-reliance in ammunition and defense systems, the first indigenous Loiter Munition (LM), Nagastra-1 Solar Industries Nagpur It has been designed and developed by Economics Explosives Limited (EEL), a subsidiary of EEL, in association with Z-Motion, Bangalore. The Nagastra-1 model was displayed at the recently held Army Commanders' Conference in New Delhi. Drone technology has proven to be very important in military operations and has been used in recent conflicts, especially in the case of Armenia-Azerbaijan, Syria, Saudi Arabia's oil fields, and Russia-Ukraine.

According to government officials, Ayodhya has been selected for this pilot project because there is a possibility of a significant increase in the number of devotees here after the opening of the Ram temple in the month of January next year. This will make disposal of garbage a major issue for the corporation. Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Tirath Kshetra Trust has estimated lakhs of devotees to visit it every month.
