1. According to RBI , Tamil Nadu tops the market borrowing for the third year in a row



Tamil Nadu has emerged as the top market borrowing state for the third consecutive year, according to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data.Tamil Nadu's gross borrowing through State Development Loans (SDLs) during the April-February period of FY 2023 Market borrowings stood at Rs 68,000 crore. Tamil Nadu, plans to raise a debt of ₹1,43,197.93 crore during 2023-24 and also proposes to repay ₹51,331.79 crore, taking the net debt to ₹91,866.14 crore. The fiscal deficit is estimated at 3.25% of GSDP as per the budget estimates for 2023-24. Before the pandemic, the average Gross Fiscal Deficit to Gross Domestic Product (GFD-GDP) ratio of states was modest at 2.5% during 2011-12 to 2019-20, well below the Fiscal Responsibility Legislation (FRL) cap of 3%.

2. Santiago Peña of the right-wing Colorado party wins Paraguay's presidential election



44-year-old conservative leader Santiago Peña has won the presidential election in Paraguay. Santiago is an economist. With Peña's victory, it has been decided that the right-wing Colorado party will once again form a government in Paraguay. Santiago Peña won 43 percent of the total 99 percent of the vote in Paraguay. During the election campaign, Peña made big promises such as creating jobs, reducing energy prices and ending the drug trade. That Paraguay's relations with America could be bad. In fact, Pena is close to former Paraguayan President Horacio Cartes. Cartes is the president of Paraguay's ruling Colorado Party. Paraguay has been under the dictatorship of General Alfredo Stroessner, but since then Paraguay's power has been held by the Colorado Party.

3. Debdutt Chand became the new Managing Director of Bank of Baroda



Debdutt Chand has been appointed as the Managing Director (MD) of Bank of Baroda (BoB).Chand is currently serving as the Executive Director of the bank. The appointment comes after the tenure extension of previous MD Sanjiv Chadha was extended by the government for an additional five months till June 30, 2021. The appointment notification was issued after approval from the Appointments Committee of the Cabinet headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. In January this year, the Financial Services Institutions Bureau (FSIB), which is responsible for recruiting directors for state-owned banks and financial institutions, awarded him a B.Tech degree from the Odisha University of Agriculture and Technology and Indian Social Welfare and Business Management. He has done MBA in Finance from the institute.

4. Ding Liren becomes China's first world chess champion

Ding Liren has become the 17th World Chess Champion by defeating Ian Nepomniachtchi of Russia. Ding defeated Nepo in the last of four rapid tiebreaks. Ding replaced Magnus Carlsen of Norway as the winner of the World Chess Championship after he and Nepomniachtchi finished with seven points each after 14 games in the first leg played in the Kazakhstan capital Astana. Each had three wins, while the other eight ended in draws. For the tie-break phase of the match, in Astana itself, the contenders had only 25 minutes to make their moves, with an additional 10 seconds for each move. The 30-year-old took advantage of his opponent's mistakes to win the rapid chess playoff by 2.5 points to 1.5.

5. Uttar Pradesh honored with 'HUDCO Award' for 'Swachh Virasat Abhiyan'





He joined the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS) in London as a Sanskrit teacher while completing his PhD, and has been its executive director since 1995.
