

1. Forbes released the list of world's 10 highest earning sportspersons



International football stars Cristiano Ronaldo (\$136 million), Lionel Messi (\$130 million) and Kylian Mbappe (\$120 million) round out the top three highest-paid players. Ronaldo is a player with an estimated net worth of \$136 million, including \$46 million from his playing \$90 salary and bonuses, and million from endorsements, appearances, licensing income, and other business operations. Johnson, who ranks No. 6 with \$107 million, has made news for both top ten highest-earning players. While off-field earnings are an estimate that comes from sponsorship deals, appearance fees and memorabilia and licensing income. It also includes cash returns from businesses run by the player. The ten highest-paid athletes in the world earned a combined total of \$1.11 billion over the past 12 months.



3. University Grants Commission launches 'CU-Choice' portal

4. ISRO's first 'Starberry' sensor successfully tested



The Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) recently launched a low-cost star sensor called StarBerry-Sense, mounted on the PSLV Orbital Experimental Module (POEM), Starberry-Sense is a low-cost sensor It is designed to quickly calculate the orientation of a spacecraft by identifying stars in its field of view. Developed by the Space Payloads Group at the Indian Institute of Astrophysics (IIA), StarBerrySense is built under the Raspberry Pi minicomputer, which is costeffective and simple to manufacture. POEM is a unique initiative of ISRO which uses the fourth stage of PSLV as an orbital platform for scientific experiments, that it is working as expected in the harsh conditions of space,

5. India and Israel signed MoU for industrial research

As a significant achievement in the science and technology cooperation between India and Israel, the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) under the Ministry of Science and Technology of India and the Directorate of Defense Research and Development (DDR&D) of the Ministry of Defense of Israel An MoU was signed between the two for industrial research and development. During his career, Douglas appeared at Cannes to promote films such as The China Syndrome, Basic Instinct, Falling Down, Wall Street: Money Never Sleeps and Behind the Candelabra.

7. According to the National Manufacturing Innovation Survey 2021-22, Karnataka is the most 'innovative'



survey on the degree of innovation among manufacturing firms found that Karnataka, overall, is the most "innovative" state, followed by Telangana and Tamil Nadu. The National Manufacturing Innovation Survey (NMIS) 2021-22, released earlier this month, also found that innovation in manufacturing is lowest among

northeastern states (except Assam), followed by Bihar. There is a need to spur innovation in over 8,000 km of manufacturing across 28 states and 6 union territories (UTs), covering the manufacturing and related service sector and MSMEs. The focus on innovation in manufacturing will also lead to higher ranking of India in the Global Innovation Index. Last year, India ranked 40th out of 132 countries on the index. large, medium,

8. India's unemployment rate rose to 8.11% in April from 7.8% in March



India's unemployment rate rose to a four-month high of 8.11% in April 2023, according to data from research firm Center for Monitoring India Economy. The nationwide unemployment rate rose from 7.8% in March, with urban unemployment rising from 8.51% to 9.81% in the same period. However, rural unemployment declined marginally to 7.34% in April from 7.47% a month ago. Despite a rise in unemployment, India increased its labor force participation by 25.5 million to 467.6 million in April, taking the overall participation rate to 41.98%. As per the Annual Periodic Labor Force Survey reports, there is a declining trend in the unemployment rate among graduate degree holders. The data on employment and unemployment is collected through PLFS, which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation.
