

1. Uttar Pradesh becomes first state to make digital health card for children



Uttar Pradesh has become the first state in the country to make digital health cards for children. In order to provide quality education to every student, the Yogi government has started the 'School Health Program' under the Urban Development Department and Lucknow Smart City. Under the pilot project, School Health Program has been started by Lucknow Smart City in three schools of Lucknow. Digital health report cards of 1765 students studying in municipal schools are being prepared after conducting physical and mental health tests. Along with this, the benefit of health insurance of Rs 25 thousand is also being given to these children.

4. Kerala becomes the first state in the country to bring 'Institutional Ranking Framework'



Higher Education Minister, R Bindu has officially the Kerala Institutional introduced Ranking Framework (KIRF) which is designed to rate the quality of higher education institutions in Kerala. It will be implemented annually by the Kerala State Higher Education Council (KSHEC). This initiative has made Kerala the first state in India to set up a ranking framework exclusively for its higher education institutions. The Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework has been developed with the aim of creating a more democratic and secular approach to the grading and ranking system in Kerala. The framework has been launched by the Kerala State Council of Higher Education and KSHEC, the state aims to establish a state-level institutional ranking framework retaining the core features and components of the National Institutional Ranking Framework.
