



1. First ministerial meeting of India-EU Trade and Technology Council to be held in Belgium



The first ministerial meeting of the India-EU Trade and Technology Council (TTC) will be held in Brussels, Belgium on 16 May. The meeting will discuss ways to enhance cooperation in strategic technologies, digital connectivity, clean energy, trade and investment. Commerce Ministry said in an official statement that Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar and Minister of State for Electronics and Information Technology Rajeev Chandrasekhar will attend the meeting. At the same time, the European Union will be led by its Executive Vice Presidents Dombrovskis and Vestager. According to the ministry, in this meeting, three working groups will present reports for future cooperation between the two sides. The first working group deals with technologies, strategic digital governance and digital connectivity. The second working group deals with green and clean energy technologies, while the third working group deals with trade,

2. India-Indonesia's fourth bilateral exercise 'Samudra Shakti-23' started



Indigenously designed and built Anti-Submarine Warfare Corvette INS Kavaratti arrived Batam, Indonesia to participate in the 4th edition of India-Indonesia bilateral exercise 'Samudra Shakti-23'. The exercise will see the participation of Dornier maritime patrol aircraft and Chetak helicopters of the Indian Navy. The Indonesian Navy will be represented by KRI Sultan Iskandar Muda, CN 235 Maritime Patrol aircraft and AS565 Panther helicopters. Samudra Shakti aims to enhance interoperability and mutual cooperation between the two navies. The harbor phase of the exercise includes cross deck visits, professional interactions, subject matter expert exchanges and sports fixtures, while the sea phase includes weapon helicopter operations, anti-submarine firings, warfare and air defense exercises and boarding operations. 3. India won 3 medals for the first time in the Men's World Boxing Championship held in Tashkent



India ended the IBA Men's World Boxing Championship 2023 with three medals in Tashkent, Uzbekistan. Indian boxers Deepak Kumar, Mohd Hussamuddin and Nishant Dev ended their campaign with bronze medals. With three bronze, India finished joint fourth in the medals tally at the prestigious tournament, which was topped by hosts Uzbekistan with 9 medals, followed by Cuba and Russia (6 each) and Kazakhstan (5). 2019 Asian silver medalist Deepak (51kg) put up a tough fight against two-time world bronze medalist Bilal Benama of France in the semi-finals after a review of the bout. However, in the end they had to face

defeat 4-3. Like Deepak, Nishant (71kg) too suffered a 2-5 defeat after review of his bout against defending Asian champion Aslanbek Shimberganov of Kazakhstan. meanwhile,

5. Prof. Jayant Vishnu Narlikar receives India's first 'Astronomical Society Govind Swaroop Lifetime Achievement Award'

Jayant Vishnu Narlikar is the most fitting and deserving recipient of the first Govind Swarup Lifetime Achievement Award of the Astronomical Society of India (ASI), an outstanding astronomer, Inter-University Center for Astronomy Astrophysics (IUCAA) , was also the founder director of Pune and former chairman of ASI. Although the award was announced earlier this year at the 41st meeting of the ASI held at the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Indore, Professor Narlikar was unable to travel to receive it. ASI President Prof. Dipankar Banerjee, Prof. Narlikar was present in Pune to personally hand over the award and felicitate him. On this occasion, Prof. Banerjee said, "Although the scope of work of Prof. Swarup and Prof. Narlikar differed widely, However, both remained deeply committed to the development of astronomy and astrophysics by building exemplary institutions and made great efforts to provide astronomy training to the younger generation. They both continue to serve as wonderful role models for generations to come. It is an honor for me to hand over the award to our dear teacher Jayant. Colleagues of the National Center for Radio Astrophysics (NCRA) are also Prof. Narlikar and are happy that this award in the name of its founder, Prof. Narlikar, who is the founder of the nearby institute IUCAA.
